## **Key Takeaways**

## **Discussion**

- 1. What does the story about the linen belt teach us about our relationship with God and the consequences of not listening to Him?
- 2. How do you see the issue of "false prophets" or misleading voices manifesting in today's Christian landscape?
- 3. How can we cultivate better discernment in distinguishing true spiritual guidance from false teachings in today's information-saturated world?
- 4. How can we strike a balance between being open to spiritual experiences and avoiding the 'sensational' aspects of faith that may lead us astray?
- 5. What does it mean practically to stay "Gospel-centric" in your daily life and decision-making?

## **Practical Applications**

- 1. **Media Fast:** Take a break from Christian social media or podcasts for a week. Instead, spend that time reading Scripture and praying.
- 2. **Gospel Reflection:** Write down the core elements of the gospel as outlined in <u>1</u> Corinthians 15:3-4. Reflect on how these truths impact your daily life.
- 3. **Discernment Practice:** The next time you encounter a teaching or prophecy, practice evaluating it against Scripture.
