- <u>Bags</u>- Ziploc (Quart or Gallon) & Trash Bags
- <u>Baby Supplies</u> (diapers, clothing, bottles, utensils, etc.)
- Books
- Canned Goods (fruit, tuna, beans, etc.)
- <u>Cleaning Supplies</u> (bleach, Clorox wipes, brooms, dish soap, nitrile gloves, laundry detergent
- Clothing (gently used or new)
 - *Only gently used and new clothing will be accepted. All donated socks and underwear must be new.*
- <u>Clothing Accessories</u> (handbags, jewelry, and shoes
