1. Sarah Marshall, Colorado Natural Heritage Program, Wetlands Assessment and Mapping Tools
 Tracking wetland changes to monitor drought/aridification and beaver wetland complexes over time using repeatable low-cost Machine Learning techniques. The computer training modeling method was discussed.
 They have been able to add topographic data to inform the probability of wetland occurrence. Using information in the plains and identifying diverse classes of wetlands. Helpful for looking at beaver wetland functions in sediment capture, fire, drought resilience, and habitat. Urban beaver conflict zones, habitat connectivity, and mapping tool uses were discussed.
