A suggestion was made to focus on four tenants of the water plan with the intention to advance RT sponsored projects that advance the Colorado Water Plan.

Have a committee for each tenant with a champion for each (CWP Chapter 6).

- Thriving Watershed Able to adapt to change without fundamentally altering the services upon which society and the environment depend.
- Vibrant Communities Balance water supply and demand needs to create a sustainable urban landscape, planning that integrates land use and water solutions.
- Robust Agriculture Sustainable agricultural economy and culture where farms and ranches are profitable and a high quality of life for farming communities is maintained.
- Resilient Planning Forward-thinking solutions to create strong equitable communities that are able to
 effectively respond to water-related challenges.
 - a. Reference to the survey that identified ten themes of interest that were narrowed down to three.
 - i. Study of landscape vegetation that would be sustainable in future with warmer climate.
 - ii. Study environmental and socio-economic benefits of urban landscapes.
 - iii. Region-specific water use/efficiency analysis and recommendations for targets for the SPB.

The committee is trying to restart this initiative and tie it to the grant cycles for the CWP and WSRF.

This approach should start at a small group level then bring ideas to the larger group. It may require reaching out to the other Committees to garner interest in joining this effort.
