

Commission Examples








My client sent images from my website of paintings that resonated, and I created a digital mockup, keeping in mind their materials and finishes, for approval. I then went to their home to measure for the perfect size. **Expert Tip:** use painter's tape to help visualize the ideal scale.

This was a collaborative effort with my client and her interior designer. I had solid direction and a lot of freedom, which I find produces the best outcomes.




How did this begin?

As commissions tend to go, thunder no.3 was modeled after the slightly smaller thunder no.2, which I was in the process of completing when my clients:

- saw the progress photos on Instagram
- scheduled a studio visit.
- fell in love with no.2 in person
- asked me to make something similar in spirit at a much larger scale

I often prefer commission work to control for scale, color, and composition, with each painting custom-created and site-specific. I also like to work in series exploring the themes in depth as they evolve into new and unique expressions.





Based on the original "Therapy" painting from 2008, this is a reimagined version at a larger scale. The spirit of the original resides in the 2018 version, but as you can see, it is a unique painting in its own right.




"Therapy" (2008) oil and collage on canvas, 40x60"






"Abstract Interior no.51"

I love going from a tiny collage to a gigantic painting while staying true to the small. The idea is to blow them up at least ten times the original size into statement paintings that are more spacious and minimal. They become like gigantic pages out of a sketchbook. I make the collages from fragments of other works, giving these pieces a second chance at life. Then I blow them up and make them monumental.





My small sketch study used as the reference point for the large painting.














I made four small studies so the client could approve one example as a reference for the large-scale painting. They selected the top left and asked for more blues and light colors in the final picture in addition to the sea green.

Installation view of "Ocean no.1" (2013) Oil on canvas 72×72 " PRIVATE COLLECTION (Indianapolis, IN)




