The Rehabilitation Counselling profession

Rehabilitation Counsellors primarily focus on providing counselling, guidance, and support to individuals with disabilities or injuries. Helping clients navigate the emotional and psychological aspects of their condition, set goals, and develop strategies to overcome barriers while providing vocational guidance, job placement, and assistance with community integration.

What do Rehabilitation Counsellors do?

Rehabilitation Counsellors are unique because we use the biopsychosocial framework and "work participation" as a therapeutic modality in our service provision. As such, we address broad health outcomes ranging from mental health, physical, employment and social perspectives.

Our ability to negotiate outcomes with various stakeholders, as a part of our standard practice, enables us to counsel clients about self-efficacy, confidence, resilience and how to navigate themselves within the workers compensation setting.

Our natural tendency though training and practice, to involve all the stakeholders in the return to work process and link in with employers, gives us an advantage of working within the various Schemes whereby we understand the importance of the well-established injury management principles as well as the Health Benefits of Good Work.



REHABILITATION COUNSELLING

The Rehabilitation Counselling process involves communication, goal setting, and beneficial growth or change through self-advocacy, psychological, vocational, social, and behavioural interventions and may also include:

- Assessment, vocational evaluation, and appraisal
- Treatment planning (with other professions)
- Career (vocational) counselling
- Individual and group counselling treatment interventions focused on facilitating adjustment to the medical and psychosocial impacts of disability
- Case management, referral, and service coordination
- Program evaluation and research
- Interventions to remove environmental, employment, and attitudinal barriers as well as to enhance work adjustment
- Knowledge of disability-related legislation and regulations and of community resources
- Consultation services among multiple parties and regulatory systems
- Expert witness testimony
- Job analysis and modification, job development, and placement services, including assistance with employment and job accommodations
- The provision of consultation about access to relevant rehabilitation technologies
- Mediation, facilitated conversations and negotiations
