

# **Fundraiser Steps:**

- 1. Choose what type of fundraiser you want to host.
- 2. Invite guests with our sample invitations, social media posts and/or flyers.
- 3. Share our event tickets and/or thank you letters with guests during or after the event.
- 4. Donate online to a charity that promotes literacy and early reading experiences: <u>First Book</u>, <u>Barbara Busch Foundation</u>, <u>Scholastic</u>, <u>Zero to Three</u>, <u>Books for Kids</u>, <u>Reading Partners</u>. You can also fundraise to buy discounted books from <u>Scholastic</u> or <u>The Book Bundler</u> to donate books locally. Use <u>the Book Donation Map</u> to find local sites accepting book donations or coordinate with a local day care or head start that serves children in need.




#### **HOST A FUNDRAISER**


I am hosting a party with a purpose fundraiser to support early childhood literacy.

**CAPTION 5:** Join my **Wine Tasting for Words** <u>Birthday Fundraiser</u>! Bring <u>\$5 in singles</u> to rank your 3 favorite wines (\$3, \$2, \$1). I'll provide the wine and your donation will provide vocabulary instruction to children in need. RSVP: <u>Location</u>, <u>date @ time!</u>
