

By signing up and obtaining an account with the SAGES Video Acquisition Portal, you have acknowledged that this is a data donation agreement between you and the Society of American Gastrointestinal and Endoscopic Surgeons (SAGES), with its offices at 11300 W. Olympic Blvd, Suite 600, Los Angeles, CA 90064 USA, and that you have understood and agreed with the terms and conditions of this agreement, which are delineated below:

- SAGES is soliciting donations of videos of Laparoscopic Cholecystectomies for the purpose
 of conducting research studies. The first research project is a Computer Vision Challenge
 on the identification of the Critical View of Safety during Laparoscopic Cholecystectomy
 (described in <u>www.cvschallenge.org</u>). This project and its derivatives are not intended for
 commercial reasons. The results of the study will be published in scientific journals.
- Those videos must have been collected and/or developed within the framework of clinical quality improvement, and scientific and/or educational research approved by operative surgical consent from the patient or other means of institutional approval (e.g. Ethics Committee, Institutional Review Board, etc).
- You are donating a copy of the original video, which will be completely deidentified. You have the rights to retain the original video, and SAGES will make no claims related to the original video footage.
- The SAGES Video Acquisition Portal provides a secure de-identification process within its framework to remove Protected Health Information (PHI) from the video data and metadata; however, it is still the best practice and your responsibility to ensure that no PHI is included in the video after the de-identification process has occurred and prior to finalizing the submission to SAGES (NIH guidelines reference https://privacyruleandresearch.nih.gov/pr 08.asp).
- After a de-identified video has been submitted to SAGES, it will not be possible to link the video with its originating donor, and it will be part of the collective dataset. After submitting, donations are non-traceable and cannot be revoked or returned.
- You assert that you have the full legal rights to donate the data, and you are making this donation free of charge.
