One street west of Vinneford Ranch Rd. and University

The front yard features a red moss rock wall and a flowering Aristocrat pear. A triangular flagstone area was used to bridge the driveway and front entrance. Slope problems on both sides were solved with different approaches: the west side features a path of flagstone winding among native pines and aspens which provides a smooth surface for the lawnmower. The east side begins with a flagstone walkway but leads to an intricate series of tie steps and landings, intertwined with mulched planting boxes.

Broadway south to Wildcat Reserve Pkwy. east, south on Poston; right on Amesbury Way, Addison Ct. and Danbury Ave. Left on Newbury Ct.

The front yard features a stacked 8" buff flagstone wall accenting the front patio; includes rock pathways and assorted decorative rock and mulch planting beds.

3115, 3075 Danbury Ct. / 3003 E. Newbury Ct.

Along the two blocks back from Tolbert residence to Addison Ct.

All three brothers have similar landscapes designed with planting berms in front with decorative rock and granite boulders. Complete irrigation systems were installed for grass, plant material and garden areas.

South on University to Highlands Ranch Parkway west. Go south on East Clairton Dr., Clairton St.
