
Harvesting Hunted Animals for Petfood Examination



Everyone intending to supply hunted animals for petfood must understand the key requirements for harvesting and supplying poison-free hunted animals.

Intending suppliers are required to demonstrate knowledge of the "Operational Code: Petfood Processing" and the training booklet "Harvesting Hunted Animals for Petfood".

Instructions:

- 1. Study the "Operational Code: Petfood Processing: Chapter 4 Harvesting and Processing of Hunted Animals" and the training booklet "Harvesting Hunted Animals for Petfood".
- 2. Fill in this examination form and return to the petfood processor along with the form "Application to become a Processor-Approved Hunter Petfood".
- 3. Be clear about your answers and mark the form clearly.
- 4. There is no time limit.
- 5. This is an "open-book" exam. You may refer to either publication while you are filling out the exam.
- 6. The petfood processor will mark the exam and may ask further questions to ensure you understand the key requirements for harvesting poison-free hunted animals for petfood.
- 7. If satisfied that you understand these requirements, the processor will enter your name onto their list of approved hunters.
