

Suburb overview: Buderim

Buderim is a Kabi word meaning honeysuckle or red soil. It has a verdant atmosphere, characterised by leafy streets lined with Poinciana trees.

Buderim is 95km north of Brisbane via the Bruce Highway, 7km due west and up the hill from Mooloolaba. The Buderim Plateau ranges from 152 m to 182 m above sea level and is 7 km long and 4 km at its widest point.

The main attractions are the Buderim Forest Waterfall Walk, Buderim Falls (also known as Serenity Falls) and the Foote Sanctuary.

Buderim is known for its great diversity of architectural styles, from classic 'Queenslander' to ultra-modern one-offs. Some homes, especially those "on top" of Buderim with ocean views, sell for seven-figure prices.

The centre of Buderim, with its many cafes and boutique stores, is central to the entire Sunshine Coast and is just 10 minutes from the beaches of Maroochydore, Alexandra Headland and Mooloolaba.

Various bus routes connect Buderim with Maroochydore, Caloundra, Nambour and other centers

A little bit of history

Before the timber loggers arrived, the Buderim area was inhabited by Kabi Kabi Aboriginal people. Their language is thought to have included a word sometimes spelled "Badderam" or "Budderum" that they used to describe the mountain.

William Henry Guy first surveyed the area in 1869, and by 1870 settlers had purchased and began clearing the land. They grew sugarcane, citrus, bananas, beans and tomatoes.


