



Reed Diffuser Safety and Instructions

First time use:

Remove the clear plastic plug from the bottle and replace the black cap. Place your reeds into the bottle.

We use a larger reed size and a small neck size to increase scent throw and minimise evaporation.

Reeds can be turned over every few days to maximise scent throw. Do this over the kitchen sink to avoid spills.

Safety:

Spills must be wiped away immediately as the liquid can stain and alter the finish of wood, plastic or painted surfaces.

This product is low VOC and free of alcohol and DPG.

Keep diffusers on a stable surface, away from children and pets.

Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
Keep away from heat, do not set alight.
Do not swallow.

Soy Wax Candles Safety Instructions

First time use: Do not use if the container is cracked or broken. For the first burn allow enough time for the melt pool to reach to the edge of the container. Jar candles may need multiple burns to achieve a full melt pool.

Cold weather conditions can affect wax appearance and burn performance. Candles should be stored and burned at room temperature, otherwise they may not burn correctly.

Safety: Never leave a lit candle unattended. Candles must be placed on a stable heat resistant surface away from children, pets and in a well-ventilated room.

Do not burn candles for more than four hours at a time.

Keep candles away from combustible materials such as textiles, paper etc.

Do not attempt to move a candle when lit. Note that the container will become hot when the candle is lit.

Trim the wick after every burn (when cooled), to avoid soot on the next burn. We use self-trimming wicks, just pinch the ends of the wick to trim.

All @eucyblue candles have been thoroughly tested for safety and efficacy under controlled conditions. The initial product design process is completed over a number of months to ensure a premium product.
