CURRICULUM

St. Johns Classical Academy provides an American classical education rooted in the liberal arts and humanities. Academics focus on history, literature, mathematics, science in conjunction with courses in Latin, logic and rhetoric, moral philosophy, economics, American government, and a wide range of co-curriculars centered around a traditional liberal arts education.

SENIOR THESIS

The capstone of a classical education at St. Johns Classical Academy is the Senior Thesis project. This project provides a final opportunity for scholars to reflect on their wisdom and demonstrate the skills their education has fostered. Scholars select one classical piece of literature to read and annotate. They then write a 10-page thesis that is defended against a panel.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Scholars will complete 28 credits during grades 9 through 12, including the following requirements:

- English, 4 years
- History, 4 years, including Ancient World History, European History, American history, American Government, and Economics
- Mathematics, 4 years, including Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, and Calculus
- Science, 3 years, including Biology, Chemistry, and Physics
- Language: Scholars complete 4 years of Latin beginning in 6th grade
- Co-curriculars: 4 years, including 1 year of physical education and 1 year of fine arts

AP & DUAL ENROLLMENT

AP Courses Offered: AP Physics and AP Calculus BC. AP courses are only offered at St. Johns Classical Academy if they align with the school's curriculum.

Dual Enrollment Offered: Dual Enrollment courses are not offered at St. Johns Classical Academy, however juniors and seniors in the 2023-2024 school year can take up to two online Dual Enrollment courses with the approval of the Academic Advisor.
