GENERAL FEES

Facility Fee: \$ 15 Assessed all riders AHJA Office Fee: \$10 assessed all riders AHJA Non-Member Fee: \$10 Assessed all non-member riders Late Entry Fee: \$30 Assessed per rider after Wednesday, Sept 21, 2022. Paramedic Fee: \$10 Assessed all riders Stall Fee: \$55 Per night/includes shavings

<u>SHOW FEES</u> Class Fee: \$18 Per class Bill Wolf Memorial Classic: \$25

Proper hunt attire is required for all recognized hunter classes.

In all classes wherein the rules of the sanctioning association(s) do(es) not apply, Management shall settle any dispute or question that may arise and its decision shall be final. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition or entries, and cancel or combine classes, or to reschedule classes, to change rings or rotate judges; and to change specifications in classes.

BILL WOLF MEMORIAL CHALLENGE: The Bill Wolf Memorial will be the second round of you declared division. Ensure that you let the Show Secretary and In Gate person know what division you are using for you Challenge. One division per rider/horse. Only classes in Ring 1 are eligible for the Challenge.

Purse \$500: 1st Place: \$200, 2nd Place: \$150, 3rd Place: \$75, 4th Place: \$50, and 5th Place: \$25.

TROPHIES & RIBBONS - Every AHJA class offered herein will be placed 1st-6th and awarded five ribbons. The Walk/Trot and Crosspole Divisions will be awarded 10 ribbons. **CHAMPION AND RESERVE** - Awarded based on 10, 6, 4, 3, 2, and 1.5 in all Hunter divisions.

DISCOURTESY - To any Show Official by any owner, rider, trainer, handler or groom will disqualify any horses with which they are associated and fees for horses forfeited. **STALLS AND BEDDING** – Limited stalls and paddocks are available starting the day before the show. Contact Guerry Force at 205.381.0364 for stall and shavings reservations by Wednesday, September 21, 2022 by 6:00 pm. Stalls - \$55 Day Pens - \$40 Paddocks - \$50

SCHOOLING - In designated areas only. Open schooling is allowed Friday until 6 pm and 30 minutes prior to the arena start times Saturday and Sunday.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES- dirt bikes, golf carts. Only licensed drivers allowed to drive any motor vehicle.

CONCESSIONS - will be available on the Show Grounds provided Saturday.

DOGS - Must be leashed and under control of the owner or dog may be impounded.

COGGINS TEST - Negative certificates dated within 1 year are required for admittance with state and local laws.



WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

A. AHJA RULES AND POLICIES: I agree to be bound and to abide by the rules and policies

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with equestrian sports, and know that

horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that any AHJA-sponsored event involves risks and dangers, including, without limitation, the potential

for serious bodily injury, sickness and disease, including communicable diseases among humans or animals, trauma, pain and suffering, bites, kicks, abrasions, contusions or other

injury or disability, allergic reactions, falls, paralysis, death, loss or damage to personal property, including without limitation to trailers, vehicles, tack, equipment, horses or other animals, and other unknown risks and dangers.

I specifically acknowledge that Alabama and the United States is currently battling the pandemic

associated with COVID-19, a highly transmissible infectious disease, and agree that I will comply

with any and all safety measures and social distancing protocols instituted by the AHJA and the
