The history of trapper life beginning in 1938 is captured on the site of Trapper Leas Cabin where he established a living trapping wolves and bears for their pelts. Site is nearby the geographic center of Alberta.

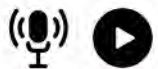

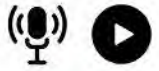

# A Thriving Natural Playground

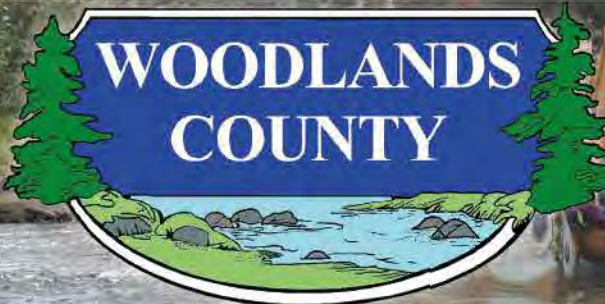

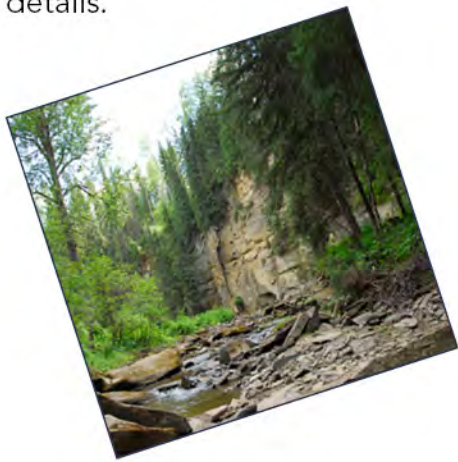


## 4 MacLeod River Tubing

## 3 Hard Luck Canyon

Whether you are an avid hiker or a leisurely stroller, you will find what you are looking for at Hard Luck Canyon. Carved by Hard Luck Creek through the sandstone layers of the Paskapoo Formation, Hard Luck Canyon is a unique geological feature within Woodlands County.



## 5 Schuman Lake

Located 24 km west of Fort Assiniboine on Secondary Highway 658 is charming Schuman Lake – a great place to spend the day fishing. A full day-use area exists at the site with free access to picnic and barbecue areas.

## 2 E.S. Huestis Demonstration Forest

This is the perfect outing for individuals who are passionate about the environment or for those with a general interest in the forestry practices that have shaped the Woodlands County region and the province of Alberta.
