1 Klondyke Ferry

One of six cabled ferries remaining in Alberta, this ferry is a free 10-minute ride for pedestrians, cyclists and motorized vehicles near Vega. A picturesque meadow welcomes you at the south landing, along with a self-registration 10-unit



2 Barrhead Golf & Recreation Area

This 18-hole championship course designed by the renowned Les Furber has been included in Golf Digest's "Best Places To Play" three years running, and is a must-stop for all golf enthusiasts. Highlighted by a challenging 6,650-yard layout and pristine manicuring, be sure to enjoy the pro shop, golf lessons, restaurant and 25 powered RV stalls onsite.



3 Misty Ridge Ski Hill

With over 100 acres of runs overlooking the scenic Athabasca River, skiiers and snowboarders of all ages and abilities are welcome on the numerous hills. Well groomed nordic and alpine trails make this a cross country skiing and snowshoeing destination. Located 35 kms northwest of Barrhead.

4 BUMP - Barry's Ultra Motorsports Park

BUMP is nature at its best for off-road dirt bikes and mini quads under 70cc. Over 40 kms of single-track trails and several different styles of motocross tracks with elevation changes. Located 45 minutes northwest of Edmonton.

5 Holmes Crossing Sandhills Eco Reserve

This nature lovers' paradise is located 39 kms northwest of Barrhead and contains some of the best examples of transverse sand dunes in Canada, stabilized with jack pine lichen forests. The surrounding small lakes offer habitat for bears, deer, bobcats, birds and much more wildlife.
