Postdoctoral Fellowship in Clinical Psychology

Eligibility

Applicants must have a completed doctoral degree in Clinical Psychology or Counseling Psychology from a university-based program (PhD or PsyD) accredited by either the American Psychological Association (APA) or the Canadian Psychological Association (CPA) by their Fellowship start date. Additionally, applicants must have completed a one-year doctoral internship accredited by the APA or CPA by their Fellowship start date.

Location

Alliance Psychology is located in San Antonio, Texas. The practice is a 25 minute drive from downtown San Antonio, and approximately 20 minutes from the San Antonio International Airport. San Antonio is a vibrant, diverse city that boasts extensive history, culture, city pride, and commerce.

Program

The Alliance Psychology Postdoctoral Fellowship is built upon the principles of working as a generalist within a sustainable private practice. These principles emphasize providing quality psychological services to a diverse clinical population, developing a strong sense of clinical self-awareness through rigorous training, and collaborating within a collegial environment.

Training Philosophy

The Fellowship embraces the practitioner-scholar model of training, prioritizing ethical practice informed by research, theory, and consultation. Through supervision, didactics, and consultation, Fellows will learn the fundamentals of setting the professional and therapeutic frame that fosters quality care and sustainability.

Training is competency-based, centered around profession-wide and program-specific domains. Through the Alliance referral network, Fellows will build a full caseload of at least 20 hours of psychotherapy per week, as well as one psychological assessment per month. The Fellowship is a full time position, with Fellows required to be on site for approximately 40 hours per week.

This Fellowship provides the necessary postdoctoral training and supervision hours required for licensure to practice psychology within the state of Texas.



Facility

Alliance is a newly built facility that is owned by the practice, featuring fully furnished offices with a modern design. The practice staffs eleven clinicians, composed of licensed psychologists, as well as one licensed professional counselor supervisor, one licensed clinical social worker supervisor, and one psychiatrist.

Curriculum

In addition to developing their full caseload of therapy and psychological assessment, Fellows will attend weekly didactics in the form of case conferences, business development meetings, and individual supervision. There

will also be a syllabus of assigned scholarly readings, as well monthly continuing education and professional development opportunities.

Compensation & Benefits

This Fellowship is a salaried position, and is not impacted by the amount of services provided. The salary is \$45,000 for a one-year commitment. Additional benefits include full access to psychological testing materials, access to our EHR, and fully furnished offices to provide services. Fellows must provide their own computer/tablet for our EHR.
