Pastor's Letter

Fill us With Wonder

July 23, 2023

Dear Parish Family,

For the next couple of weeks, I will be spending some vacation time among the mountains and lakes of the Adirondacks. For me, it is always a peaceful and renewing experience. It's a time that helps me remember that the wilderness, the natural world, has a unique power to connect us to the spiritual. I was reminded of this at our summer camp earlier this summer. One day the campers came to visit the small pond fish pond behind our rectory. I knew the kids would be fascinated by the fish and the feeding frenzy that happens when some fish food is tossed into the pond. But one of the kids, walking up to the pond exclaimed: "Oh my God! I never saw a real water lily before." It was for me a priceless moment.

We have so many natural wonders here in Southampton. A prayer said at St. Andrew's Dune church reminds worshipers this week that they gather where the "glorious dunes meet the unfathomable sea." I often drive by those dunes and the sea without noticing their power and that they are a window to the beauty of creation. But sometimes I do. I will often stop by, especially in the off-season or in the early evening when the crowds have gone, just to take a moment and to be in the presence of wonder.

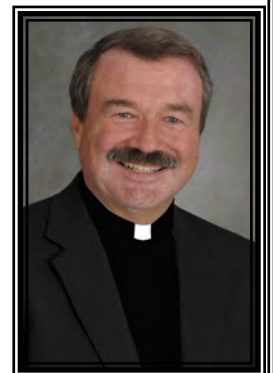
This summer I also discovered an amazing bit of technology. It is an app called Merlin Bird ID. It is able to tell what birds are nearby by interpreting their songs, which can be heard using the microphone of the phone. Often in the evening or early morning, the air is filled with their songs. Now on the screen, I see that I am hearing a Robin, Cardinal, Chimney Swift, or Screech Owl. Like a little kid seeing water lilies for the first time, I am endlessly fascinated by learning these sounds.

When we are confirmed, when we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit, we are reminded that one of the gifts is to be filled with the Spirit of Wonder and Awe in God's presence. Take some time to do that this summer. Watch a sunrise or sunset. Check out the glorious dunes and unfathomable sea, listen to the birds, be amazed at a plant you have never seen before, and, of course, recognize the hand of the creator in each of us.

Reflection On the Gospel
July 23, 2023

Those who are just must be kind.

Sunday's first reading serves as a wonderful summation of the Gospel. It speaks of a God who appears timid or lenient to some because of judging with clemency, giving ground for hope, and permitting repentance. In the Gospel, we encounter a householder whose crop of wheat is sown with weeds by an enemy. Instead of getting upset and angry, instead of ripping out the weeds or going after the enemy, he tells his servants to let the wheat and the weeds grow together. To some he, too, may appear lenient or even timid, but no; he is wise. He shows patience. He trusts the good seed to survive and make itself known as it grows, just as the weeds will reveal themselves in time. Then the two can be separated without harm to the wheat. Small seeds, like the mustard seed and yeast, have great potential, but they need time to reach it. The householder, like God, allows this to happen. May we be as willing to appear weak, so that true strength can triumph.

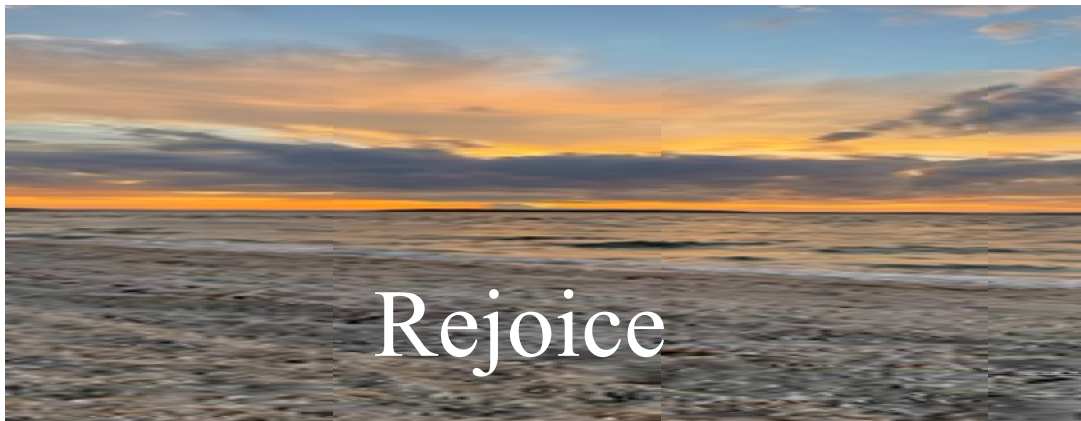

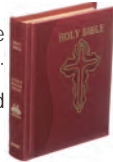
