

Framework, Scope, and Process






● **14** out of 16 **companies** (87.5%) provided information and means of verification.

 They collectively deployed 103 projects representing \$140 million in 46 countries.

- core business investment




Intervention Category	Intervention Area
Empower the Excluded	Enable participation in farmers organizations
	Investment in vocational programs for rural youth offering integrated training in multiple skills
	Scale up social protection programs
	Investment in extension services, especially for women, to accompany R&D spending
On the Farm	Agricultural interventions to support sustainable practices that are economically viable for farmers
	Support adoption of climate resilient crops
	Scale up farm level interventions in water scarce regions
	Improve quality and quantity of livestock feed for small and medium scale commercial farms
Food on the Move	Reduce post-harvest loss by focusing beyond cereals to fruits & vegetables, and other parts of the value chain
	Invest in infrastructure, regulations, technical assistance (TA) and services to support SMEs in the value chain




Ceres2030 Priority Theme - Food on the Move



Ceres2030 Priority Country / Region





FINDINGS FROM THE REPORTING EXERCISE: Conclusion

- 77% in the form of core business investments
- 56% alignment with sustainable interventions
- 34% targeting priority countries in Africa
- 5% in high priority countries
