ENTERTAINMENT **Dance Painting**

Materials: paper roll, paint, sponge roller, music, your body

- Step 1: Place at least two feet of paper on the floor. Note:
- Step 2: Pour one or two colors of paint on a plate.
- **Step 3:** Use sponges to paint the bottom of your feet.
- Step 4: Play music and dance on the paper to create art.
- Step 5: After your dance, use a paint brush to add to your artwork.
- Step 6: Hang the paper to dry.



Tile or the ground outside is better than carpet.

I Can Use Science to Provide **ENTERTAINMENT!**

Crayons are made of wax, which repels- or pushes awaywater. When you paint over crayon with watercolor paint, notice how the paint will only stick to the clean paper and not the waxy crayon marks.

Materials: 1 white crayon, water color paint set, white cardstock, water

- **Step 1:** Find your white crayon and a piece of cardstock.
- Step 2: Draw on the cardstock with your white crayon. It will be hard to see for now- that's okay!
- **Step 3:** Find your cup and fill it with water. Take out your watercolor paint and paintbrush.
- **Step 4:** Now it's time to wow your family and friends with some ENTERTAINMENT. Perform your magic trick by dipping your paintbrush in the water then swirling it in one of the watercolor paints.
- **Step 5:** Paint on your cardstock and watch your crayon artwork appear like magic!

Extension Activity: What else might keep watercolor paint from sticking to the paper? With a grown up's help, find some materials around the house to experiment with. Some suggestions: tape, glue, etc.



Make a Paper Cup Drum

Materials: plain paper cup, wax paper, rubber band, and decorations (washi tape, stickers, gems, etc).

- Step 1: Gather your materials.

- **Step 4:** Now, it's time to provide some ENTERTAINMENT for everyone with your new drum! Rock out!





Step 2: Use materials to decorate the outside of your drum any

Step 3: Take the wax paper and place it over the opening of the paper cup. While you hold the wax paper over the cup, have your grown up place the rubber band over the top of the cup to hold the wax paper tightly in place.



Ballet ENTERTAINMENT

In our story, Zuri and her friends perform steps from their ballet class to entertain friends and family. Did you know ballet vocabulary uses French language that also translates in English? See if you can put some of these movements together to create your own dance. You can always add costumes or anything else that inspires you to the final performance.

Materials: picture cards, anything in your home that helps your final performance (costumes, a place to perform, or anything that inspires you!)

- **Step 1:** Review each action on the picture cards and see how you can do that movement with your body.
- Step 2: Shuffle the cards and lay three out on the floor in front of you.
- **Step 3:** Put all three moves together in order to make a dance.
- **Step 4:** Perform your three actions together as a dance for family and friends.
- **Step 5:** Scan the QR code to perform to the music from Swan Lake, just like Zuri and her friends in the story.



Step 6: Repeat the steps with different dance cards.

Materials: Wood spoon, decoration materials (ribbons, gems, googly eyes, foam pieces)*

- Step 1: Use your materials to decorate the wooden spoon.
- **Step 2:** Use your ENTERTAINMENT Stick as a:

Magic wand in a magic show

Baton to conduct an imaginary orchestra

Ribbon wand for dance moves

Extension Activities:

Can you think of other loved ones to celebrate? Try out other art forms from the list, and use your ENTERTAINMENT Stick to celebrate them.

Go outside with your ENTERTAINMENT Stick to welcome fall or say goodbye to summer. Look around for small natural materials (such as seeds, twigs, or fallen leaves) that you can add to your ENTERTAINMENT Stick with glue or tape (not included).

Before you start your performance, make sure you have an audience full of the people you love so you can entertain them!

Materials: plastic microphone, decoration materials (stickers, washi tape, gems, etc), your own beautiful voice!

- **Step 1:** Find your very own microphone. Set aside.
- Step 2: Take out the bag of decoration materials and find some you like.
- Step 3: Decorate your microphone to get it ready for your performance.
- Step 4: Spend the next few minutes thinking of your favorite song that you want to sing for your audience. Practice a few times and throw in some dance moves and props from around your house!
- **Step 5:** Use your microphone to sing your song and provide wonderful ENTERTAINMENT for your audience!

Extension Activity: Ask your audience to join in and sing a song with you. Everyone can join in and sing or dance to create a fun performance for the whole family!

Grownups, singing with your early learner is a great way to enhance language development through exploring the rhythm of language.


Beach Ball Tennis
