A recent survey of likely voters in the special primary election in Rhode Island's first congressional district shows a plurality of voters support Lt. Governor Sabina Matos in a crowded field of Democratic candidates.

Nearly one-in-four likely (22%) voters say they support or lean toward Sabina. Her support is 2.5x higher than the next closest candidate, Aaron Regunberg, whose support is at 9%.

We interviewed 400 respondents who are registered to vote and likely to vote in the 2023 primary for Rhode Island's 1st congressional district special election. Interviews were conducted between June 5, 2023 and June 8, 2023. The margin of error for overall results is \pm 4.9%
