

# CHILDREN'S PALLIATIVE CARE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM - 2025

## PROGRAM GOALS:

- Train and empower the next generation of leaders and champions in palliative care, bringing together healthcare leaders from nursing, medicine and allied health fields in South and Southeast Asia
- Equipping clinicians to lead and champion healthcare innovations for children with serious illnesses, focussing on palliative care

## PROGRAM COMPONENTS

- 1 year training and mentorship program, which includes:
- A specialized leadership workshop (Jan 25-27, 2025, Hyderabad, India)
- Teaching and discussions with regional and international leaders and experts through monthly virtual sessions (Dec 2024-Dec 2025)
- Participants must attend monthly virtual learning sessions, complete a personal leadership project, and attend an in-person workshop in Jan 25-27, 2025 in India

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Mid-career pediatric clinicians (doctors, nurses, allied health) whose clinical work focusses on care for children with serious illnesses (including cancer) and palliative care
- Clinicians should have knowledge, skills, and clinical experience in children's palliative care
- Applications from Palliative Care Program Managers and Health Administrators will also be considered.



## HOW TO APPLY

- Download the application application and submit by July 15, 2024, successful candidates will be notified in September.
- Airfare and accommodation to the leadership workshop will be supported for successful candidates

## LEARNING TOPICS:

- **Leadership skills** – How to build successful teams, organizing teams, conflict management, resilience, self-compassion, self-reflection
- **Healthcare capacity-building** – Education programs and curriculum development, communication, strategic planning, grant writing, budgeting,
- **Communication** – Presentation skills, leveraging social media, media interview skills
