

Monday & Tuesday in Holy Week, March 25 & 26

7:00 PM The Way of the Cross
There are 14 "stations" or events of Jesus's last journey, from his meeting with the women of Jerusalem to his encounter with Simon of Cyrene. We walk in procession around the sanctuary (indoors), stopping at each station to say a prayer to commemorate each event and meditate on scripture. This is a quiet, contemplative service, ending with an intimate Eucharist gathered around the altar.

Wednesday in Holy Week, March 27

7:00 PM Tenebrae

Sung by members of the CCC adult choir, this 55-minute service leads us into the final three days of Holy Week. Beautiful and meditative, this ancient liturgy will prepare your heart and soul for the days ahead. We begin in candlelight and finish in darkness as we recall the attempt to extinguish the Light that is Christ.

Maundy Thursday, March 28

7:00 PM Holy Eucharist and Footwashing Recalling the institution of Holy Eucharist, the washing of the disciples' feet, and Jesus' time in the Garden of Gethsemane, this liturgy includes the ancient liturgy of footwashing and concludes with the stripping of the altar, with homily, hymns, and choir. **Please see our newsletter for information on

Good Friday, March 29

12:00 noon & 7:00 PM Good Friday Liturgy
The one hour Good Friday liturgy recalls
the crucifixion of Jesus Christ and invites
us to enter into his passion as we await
his resurrection, with sermon
and hymns at both services.

4:00 PM The Way of The Cross for Children In this interactive worship for children we will explore Jesus' Good Friday Journey together. Following the service children are invited to decorate Easter Eggs upstairs in the Parish Hall.

7:00 PM The Great Vigil of Easter, with Baptisms & Holy Eucharist

This ancient liturgy of the Church begins with the "first fire," recalls the history of our salvation, observes the original time for Baptisms into the faith, declares the Easter proclamation (bring bells from home to help with this!), and celebrates the first Eucharist of Easter. Join us for this festive liturgy, with choir and homily.

9:00 & 11:00 AM Festival Eucharist Easter Egg Hunt will follow the 11:00 AM service!
