OAC RULES OF THE ROAD 2025

- 1. ELIGIBILITY: Welcome driving enthusiasts! The *OpenAir Classic* (OAC) is open to any licensed, insured, street-legal convertible, T-top, roadster, or open-top Jeep type vehicle. . (Sorry, no sun-roofs).
- 2. **OBJECTIVES:** Have fun, drive great roads, meet friendly people, safely.
- **3. MEMBER'S REGISTRATION:** Members may send entries by US Postal Service beginning June 9, 2025. Postmarks before June 9 will be cycled to the end of the members' line for grid position numbers. *If you join as a member by 6/20/25 you may register as Member.* Only OAC Members will be registered for the first 200+ grid positions through June 20.
- 4. NON-MEMBERS REGISTRATION: Non-members may apply starting June 21, 2025 for open or waiting list grid positions NO FAXES, EMAIL OR DELIVERY SERVICE ENTRIES. Use U.S. Postal Service only.
- **5. REGISTRATION DEADLINES:** Final deadline for postmarked entry is July 23, 2025; however, it is likely to sell out much earlier. *Don't delay!*

WAITING LIST: Will be maintained for entries over 200+. In past years we have filled up to 5 from the waiting list.

- **6. OAC GRID LIMITS:** Directors reserve the right to adjust registration limit as they deem appropriate and necessary.
- 7. REGISTRATION IS NON-TRANSFERRABLE. NO WALK-UP REGISTRATIONS ALLOWED.
- 8. CONFIRMATIONS will be sent by email or US Mail BY AUGUST 11 indicating that your registration has been received and that you are registered. If you have not received a confirmation by AUGUST 12 please email us at info@openairtours.com. (Be sure info@openairtours.com is on your "friends" "ok" or "not-spam" e-mail list!)

- **9.DIRECTORS** reserve all rights to adjust and/or alter any parts of these tours to enhance the safety of participants and to ensure the enjoyment of all. These decisions are not subject to any appeal.
- 10. OAC TOPS DOWN START: An OAC tradition is to have a "tops down" start where all participants "drop their tops" together. Starting order will be determined by directors.
- 11. NON-COMPETITIVE: This is a tour for fun! It is not a rally or race. The only requirement will be to stop at designated check points if you want to be eligible to win prizes. Check points will be open to give everyone a reasonable time to visit and pass through. You only need arrive at the end destination by the time noted. Our objective is to ensure that everyone has a fun, safe and enjoyable tour.
- 12. ROAD SERVICE: All mechanical service and repairs are your responsibility. Though our participants are known for being helpful, be prepared to deal with breakdowns that may occur. Many people choose to join auto clubs or buy road service insurance. Please review your options and be prepared.
- 13. MEALS AND ACCOMMODATIONS: Participants are responsible for making their own arrangements for meals (except as noted in itinerary) and accommodations. - 14. REGISTRATION FEES & BENEFITS: Registration fees are \$389.00 for car, driver and a navigator. Extra passengers 6 years and over are \$90 per person. OAC Members receive a \$10.00

discount one time per membership-year as noted on entry form. NOTE: Payment accepted by CHECK ONLY.

- **15. TOUR ROUTES**, materials and events are intended for the use and enjoyment of officially registered OAC participants only. *All copy, reproduction, and distribution rights are reserved by OAC*. Any copying or sharing of routes or materials or facilitating entry into events by non-participants is prohibited. Please discuss any "guests" or extenuating circumstances with Directors
- 16. PRIZES: Each vehicle will have one entry in the Grand Prize Drawing (if it has participated all 4 days' events). Other drawings are open to all drivers and those passengers who have purchased an official game card. Member drawings are open to all participating members in good standing. Organizers reserve the right to limit prizes to one major prize per person per day.
