OPERATION BREAST DENSITY'S BREAST CANCER SCREENING SYMPOSIUM

Operation Breast Density is a 501c3 Nonprofit that is dedicated to breast cancer and breast density education.

45% of women have dense breast tissue and dense breast tissue is a significant factor to the development of breast cancer. In addition, screening mammography can miss a breast cancer diagnosis in women with dense breasts up to 40% of the time.

This Breast Cancer Screening Symposium will educate on this important topic and provide guidance to practitioners screening women for breast cancer. The symposium is an educational series taking a more individualized patient centered approach to Breast Cancer Screening. Its focus will be on breast density education and an understanding of the challenges that come with imaging women with dense breast.

The symposium's target audience is clinicians that commonly screen for breast cancer such as family medicine, internal medicine, and obstetrics & gynecology physicians as well as nurse practitioners and physician assistants in those fields.

The symposium will provide an opportunity for 3 hours of continued medical education credit for physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses and physician assistance that attend.
