Introduction

The Montana State University Billings Poll was first conducted in 1989 as the Eastern Montana College Poll under the direction of Dr. Craig Wilson. The Poll was renamed the Mountain States Poll in 2019. This report provides a summary of the statewide random sample of 204 Montana residents. Respondents were chosen through random digit dialing based on phone numbers provided by Scientific Telephone Samples (STS). Funding was provided for the Poll by the Department of Social Sciences and Cultural Studies and the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences.

The Mountain States Poll was conducted from October 11-22, 2021, in the Market Research Lab in the College of Business. The margin of error for the poll is 6.86%, with various subgroups having larger margins of error. The report contains cross-tabulations of the results based on political affiliation, gender, age, and education. The Poll was weighted based on gender, race, age, and education level. Weights were based on reports from the Census.





1.At this point in time, do you approve or disapprove of President Joe Biden's performance in office?











5. Do you approve or disapprove of the United States legalizing the use of recreational marijuana at the federal level?
















