ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

SAN FRANCISCO BASQUE CULTURAL CENTER, INC.

I

The name of this corporation shall be SAN FRANCISCO
BASQUE CULTURAL CENTER, INC.

II

(a) The purposes for which this corporation is formed is
to furnish social and recreational activities for the members of
the club with an emphasis on Basque culture.

(b) The general purposes and powers are to have and
exercise all rights and powers conferred on non-profit corporations
under the laws of the State of California, including the power to
contract, rent, buy, or sell personal or real property provided
however, that this corporation shall not except to an insubstantial
degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are
not in furtherance of the primary purposes of this corporation.

(c) No substantial part of the activities of this
corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise
attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall
not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including
the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any
candidate for public office.

III

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General
Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California. This
corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the
members thereof and it is organized for nonprofit purposes.

IV

The principal office for the transaction of business
of the corporation is located in the County of San Mateo, State
of California.

V

The general management of the affairs of the corporation

shall be under the control, supervision and direction of a board of directors which shall number three (3), until such number is changed by an amendment to these Articles or by a by-law adoption by the members provided however that the number of directors shall in no event be less than three (3). The names and addresses of the persons who are appointed to act as the first directors of the Corporation, until the selection of their successors, are as follows:

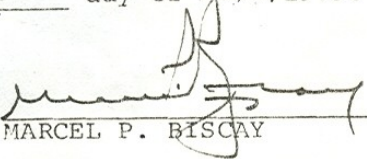
VI

The authorized number and qualifications of the members of the corporation, the different classes of membership, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the by-laws.

VII

The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to social and recreational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private individual. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for social and recreational purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If this corporation holds any assets in trust, or a corporation is formed for social and recreational purposes, such assets shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree of the Superior Court of the County in which the corporation had its principal office, upon petition therefore by the Attorney General or by a person concerned in the liquidation, in a proceeding to which the Attorney General is a party.
