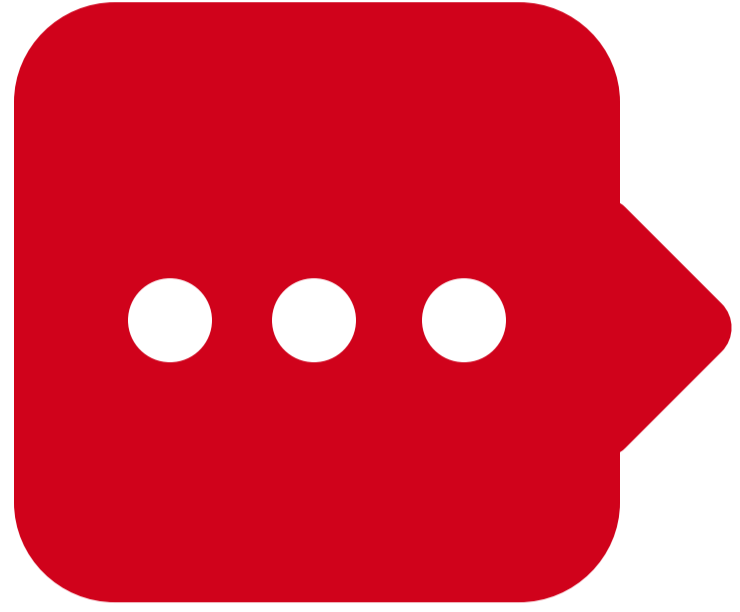


Precinct Chair Spotlight

I am interested in helping my neighbors understand issues and how they impact them.

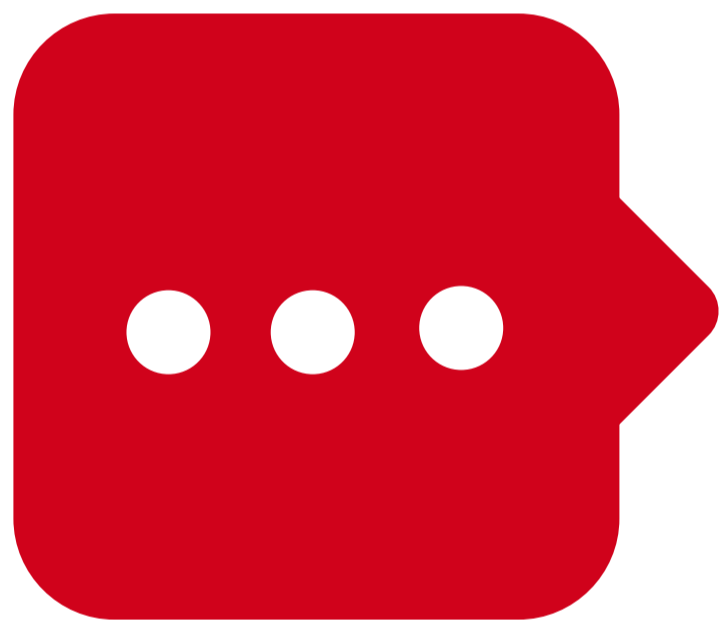

My husband, Vance, and I have been married 38 years. We have three sons, two daughters, a son-in-law, two daughters-in-law, and seven beautiful grandchildren.



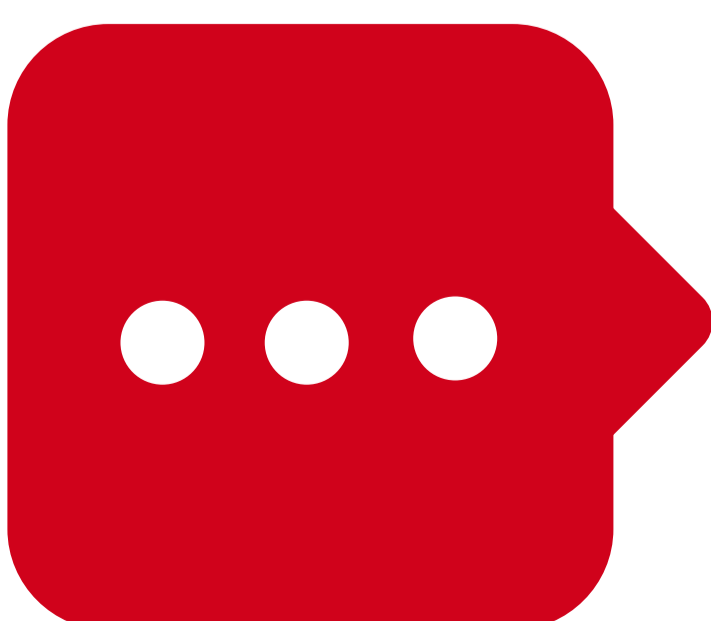
INTERESTS
