


## RINO/UNIPARTY VS. CONSERVATIVE



<b>RINO/UNIPARTY</b>	ISSUE	CONSERVATIVE
Advocates for "Top-Down" party structure with dictatorial leadership. The County Chairman retains all the power with no checks and balances from the County Executive Committee.	Republican Party Structure	Advocates for "Bottom-Up" party structure with representative, grassroots leadership. The County Executive Committee, comprised of elected Precinct Chairs, votes to make decisions through a deliberative process.
Once elected, the County Chairman is in charge and unaccountable to anyone. Uses the party brand to endorse his or her preferred candidates in the Primary Election.	Republican County Chairman	The County Chairman is a "servant leader" who carries out the business of the County Executive Committee as stated in the Party Rules and the Texas Election Code. Does not endorse in the Primary Election so as not to divide the party.
The office belongs to the Elected Official to use as he or she pleases.	Elected Officials	The office belongs to the electorate.
Divides the party by hiding behind the Republican Party brand and using resources to challenge Conservative Republicans in the Primary Election.	Candidate Endorsements	Seeks to unite the party in the effort to get Republicans elected at the local, state, and federal levels. <b>The official Republican Party</b> <b>does not endorse in the Primary Election.</b>
Fights for legislation to further subjugate the party to state laws while infringing upon the party's right to Freedom of Association (see examples <u>here</u> ).	Freedom of Association	Fights to protect the Republican brand and their right to Freedom of Association to ensure that the party can advocate for its Principles and Party Platform (see example <u>here</u> ).
Works with Democrats in a cooperative effort to defeat Conservatives in the open Primary Elections.	<b>Primary</b> <b>Elections</b>	Works in the Primary Elections to elect Republican Candidates who support the Republican Party Principles and Platform.
Does not work the General Election to support the Republican Ticket. Only works for their chosen candidates if they are on the ballot.	General Election	Works to elect all Republicans on the ballot in the General Election.

Tries to undermine Conservative activists and does not get involved in advocating for the Republican Party Principles and Platform.	Republican Principles & Platform	Stays active all year advocating for the Republican Party Principles and Platform by holding events, testifying before local boards, and working to ensure that we have an informed electorate.
Works to elect their cronies for the purpose of accumulating power, influence, and wealth.	Ultimate Goal	Works with the State Party and other Republicans to help keep our county and state "Red" by electing principled, Conservative, "servant leaders."
