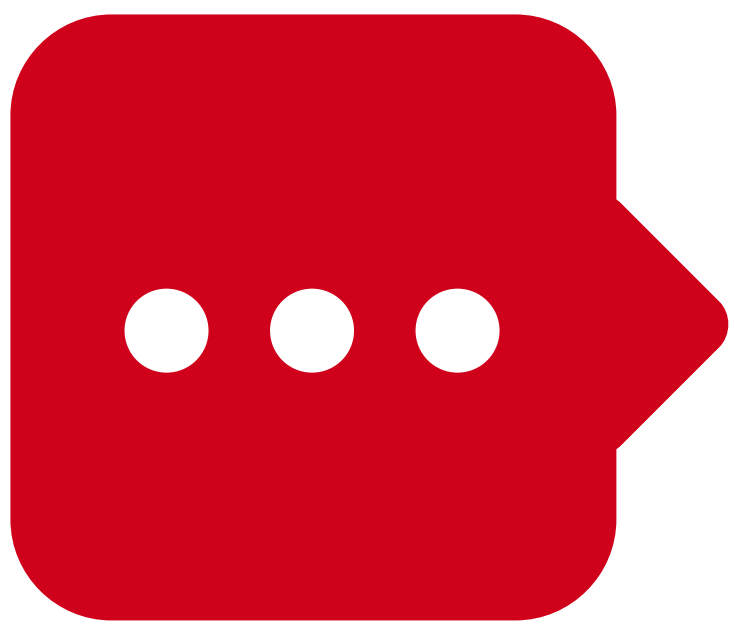


Precinct Chair Spotlight
