Position Overview

Essential Job Responsibilities

Works with the Student Ministry Leadership Team to provide a healthy environment for our students to grow in Christ and invite their friends to, while remaining in line with the identity/mission of Seaford Baptist Church.

Leading Midweek Student Ministry from 5:30pm – 8:00pm on Wednesday nights. This would include eating with the students at Midweek dinner, the planning of teaching, games and any other activities pertaining to Midweek.

Facilitating Sunday morning Sunday School from 8:30am – 9:45am. This would include organizing teachers and working with the Student Ministry Leadership Team to select curriculum.

Organizing, attending, and participating in Student Ministry events. This typically includes 1-2 additional fellowship/service events per month.

Works with the staff to ensure that Student Ministry information is being communicated and events are being executed in conjunction with the church calendar.

Helps lead the students to summer camp, attending the camp, and providing any logistical assistance that is needed.

Reads and participates in a discipleship study with the Senior Pastor.

Disciples students in smaller group settings.

Other duties and responsibilities as assigned.

Knowledge of the Bible that is suitable for the faithful teaching of students aged 11-18.

Knowledge and relational intelligence, grace, and cultural sensitivity.

Must be currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program at an accredited college/university.

Candidate must be 18 – 25 years old; must be able to provide own transportation to and from the ministry site.

Must complete Seaford Baptist Volunteer Application and Seaford Baptist-approved background check.

Candidate must be dedicated to position throughout the duration of the internship.

Candidate has an active relationship with Jesus Christ sustained through the practice of personal spiritual disciplines; consistently models Christian character.

Demonstrates commitment to unity and willingness to work in a collaborative team environment.
