

Waste Diversion & Reduction on the Front Range Through Construction & Demolition

In response to its second RFA, the Front Range Waste Diversion enterprise approved over \$1.4 million in funding for five projects geared toward reducing the amount of waste sent to landfills in Colorado's Front Range counties.

The awarded organizations, amount allocated, and projects include:

- **5280 Recycling Solutions:** \$350,147 to implement a drywall recycling program. The contract for this project was not executed per request of the awardee.
- **National Center for Craftsmanship (NCC):** \$157,190 to reduce construction and demolition waste in the Front range through deconstruction projects.
- **Perks Deconstruction:** \$124,900 to reduce the construction and demolition waste through an operation expansion.
- **Resource Central:** \$443,383 to expand reusable take-out food container operations on Colorado's Front Range.
- Western Disposal: \$338,084 to support diversion of construction and demolition through a new diversion operation within their materials management center.
