Submission Guidelines for High Schools Together for Change

- 7. Physical Submissions: Physical artwork should be turned in to the designated staff member at your respective school by March 7, 2025. Staff will coordinate collecting and delivering the artwork to Lincoln High School.
- 8. Artist Statement (Optional): Along with your artwork, you may submit a brief artist statement that provides information about your piece and shares your inspiration or the emotions reflected in your work.
- **9. Anonymity**: Artists have the option to remain anonymous or use an alternate name. If you choose to do so, please let us know in your submission.
- 10. Event Attendance: Artists do not need to attend the event but are encouraged to join us if possible.
- **11. Content Appropriateness**: We reserve the right to deny any artwork not appropriate for the event. Selection will be based on relevance to the theme of "High Schools Together for Change."
- **12. Event Details:** "High Schools Together for Change" will take place at Lincoln High School on October 29th. The event is child-friendly and open to the community.
- **13. Contact Information Sharing**: Artists have the option to share their contact information with attendees who are interested in the artist's work. Please note the artwork is NOT for sale at this event.
