

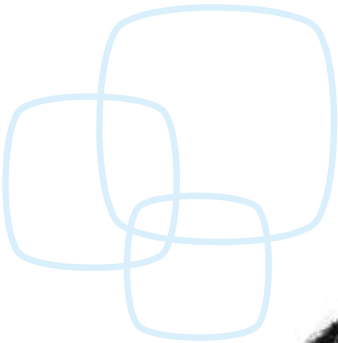
# INTRODUCTION TO RISK MANAGEMENT
