Knoxville Botanical Garden and Arboretum seeks Field Trip Leads to facilitate outdoor educational experiences for school groups, summer camps, and community organizations. This part-time position is ideal for someone who is passionate about outdoor education, eager to embrace an inquiry-learning style curriculum, ready to be adaptive and innovative, and believes in the transformational power of nature to teach, heal, and provide.

Essential Job Responsibilities:

- Facilitate dynamic, inquiry-based field trips for groups of various ages across the Garden's 44-acre property.
- Positively engage learners using curiosity, patience, redirection, and movement for effective classroom management in outdoor settings.
- Provide excellent customer service to all visitors by answering questions, assisting with wayfinding, and creating a welcoming environment.
- Collaborate with the Engagement Manager, Garden Educator, and fellow Field Trip Leads to support consistent, high-quality experiences for all groups.
- Maintain safety and group cohesion throughout the visit while adapting programming to accommodate group needs, weather, and seasonal changes.
- Support additional Garden education programs as needed.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Experience working with children or student groups, particularly in outdoor, garden, or environmental education settings.
- Excellent communication skills, with the specific ability to effectively communicate with large groups in an outdoor setting.
- Ability to work independently while also collaborating closely with other staff, teachers, volunteers, learners of all ages, to ensure the success of educational initiatives and garden-related activities.

- Ability to problem-solve and multitask while remaining organized.
- Comfortable working outdoors in all seasons and walking across uneven terrain and using stairs.
- Must have flexible weekday availability, particularly mornings between 8am—12noon, afternoons between 3pm-6pm, and occasional weekends for special programs.
- Basic computer literacy (email, calendars, Google Drive).
- Valid Driver's License.

Work Environment:

- The position is primarily outdoors in the gardens, in contact with seasonal weather, insects, and uneven surfaces.
- Light to moderate physical activity required, including standing for extended periods, walking, bending, and lifting up to 25 lbs.
- Indoor work may occasionally be required for planning or meetings.

Schedule & Compensation:

This is a part-time, seasonal position, with hours fluctuating based on scheduled field trips. KBGA currently averages 3 field trips per month with the aim of doubling that average in the next year. Peak seasons (spring and fall) will require increased availability.
