#### AFTER-CARE

We have a range of glaze options for your finished piece - and your requirements will be carefully noted and actioned once the work has been fired.

Included in the cost of the course is work weighing up to 2kg which equates to 4 small to medium pieces. A charge of £10 per additional kg clay covers further processing and materials.

Your final pieces will be tenderly looked after by the clay yard team, dried safely and loaded into the kiln for bisque firing. We will do our best to ensure your work safely emerges from both firings but we are unable to offer refunds or compensation for work damaged after your course.

We can arrange for postage of your items to a UK address for an additional charge. We will do our best to carefully package your treasured pots so that they arrive safely.
