NATIONAL STANDARDBRED HORSE SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1. Horses will be judged under SPHO national rules.
- ALL horses entered must be full-Standardbreds registered with the USTA. Must show proof of registration by lip tattoo, freeze brand and/or registration papers before entering the first class. Tattoos WILL be checked by a DQP.
- ALL STALLS MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED. Horse stalls are available at \$100 for the weekend. Tack stalls are available at \$75 for the weekend. No bedding included. Please only use shavings. No straw or other bedding is permitted. No stabling at the Horse Park before Wednesday at 6:00pm. Stalls need to be vacated from the show grounds by noon on Monday. Please note that no bedding will be available at the show.
- 4. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED BY OCTOBER 14, 2022
- 5. Pre-entries must be accompanied by an open check mailed by October 14, 2022.
- 6. Schooling in designated areas only.
- Camper hookups are available near the stable area at a fee of \$150 for the weekend.
- Proof of negative Coggins test dated within 12 months for out-ofstate horses and 24 months for instate horses. Horses coming from out of state must have a health certificate dated within 30 days of the show.
- 9. No refunds will be granted without a vet's certificate (stall, EMT and office fees will not be refunded).
- 10. Approved helmets required for exhibitors 18 years and under

when riding or driving. Speed and fun classes recommend helmets for ALL exhibitors. Failure to follow this rule will result in being excused from the ring.

- 11. Dogs will not be permitted on the premises unless restrained by a leash. \$50.00 fine will be imposed for loose dogs.
- 12. Only standard cavessons are permitted in all pleasure, hunter, and equitation classes.
- No martingales or tie-downs permitted in under saddle and equitation classes. Games excluded.
- 14. Ear bonnets permitted in puddle jumper, jumper, and speed divisions only.
- 15. Disrespect to a judge or show official will not be tolerated, and will disqualify the exhibitor, resulting in forfeiture of all entry fees.
- No one may approach the judge during the competition unless accompanied by the Show Manager.
- 17. All horses must be serviceably sound. Racing blemishes not to count. Show judge's decision will be final. If excused, remaining entry fees will be refunded.
- Exhibitors are notified that the Horse Park of NJ only allows drugs and medications to be administered by a show vet.
- 19. Holds on classes must be requested in the office before the start of the session where the conflict occurs. Only exhibitors with back-to-back classes will be granted holds.
- 20. Exhibitors are responsible for having their entries at ringside when their class is called. A "two-

minute rule" will be in effect on the gate.

- 21. Any rules that are not covered in the SPHO rule book will defer to the guidelines of the organization covering that discipline such as: English/Dressage – USDF/USEF, Western – AQHA, Driving - ECTRA
- 22. In the case of a tie for Champion, the classes used to break the tie will be marked in the Division descriptions with an exclamation point (!).
- 23. Exhibitors must declare their horses as either Rookie, Green, Novice, or Senior on the entry form. Improperly classifying your horse will result in disqualification with no refund of entry fees and will also change the horse's eligibility status.
- 24. All returned checks will be subject to a \$35 surcharge.
- 25. Neither the Standardbred Pleasure Horse Organization of NJ, Inc. nor the Horse Park of NJ will be responsible for any accident of any kind or nature that may occur to any person, animal or property, and the exhibitor shall hold the Committee or Property Owner harmless and indemnify them against any legal proceeding arising from such accident.
- 26. The Show Committee and/or the Horse Park of NJ reserve the right to amend, add or clarify any rules that are found to be unsafe, unclear or potentially misconstrued.
- 27. Any class descriptions that are not answered on this prize list will refer to the SPHO-NJ Rulebook, USEF, USDF, or AQHA guidelines.
- 28. All judge's results are official.

EQUINE/ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY CARIFICATION

- The intermediate gait is any gait the horse performs naturally between the walk and the canter. This may be a trot, jog, pace, running walk or rack. They will be judged at judges' discretion.
- A Junior Exhibitor is an exhibitor 18 years and under as of November 1st of the current show year.
- All exhibitor age restriction classes will be the age as of November 1, 2021
- SPHO-NJ Jersey Bred Horse: A horse that was sired by a stallion standing in New Jersey at time of conception or a horse that was born in NJ.

- SPHO-NJ Rookie Horse: Horses with no previous show experience.
- SPHO-NJ Green Horse: Horses which have won 0-6 blue ribbons in riding or driving events. In-Hand & non-show activities excluded.
- SPHO-NJ Novice Horse: Horses which have won 7 to 12 blue ribbons in riding or driving events.
- SPHO-NJ Senior Horse: Horses which have won more than 12 blue ribbons in riding or driving events. SPHO-NJ Open Horse All horses and riders are eligible to enter.

LIST OF DIVISIONS AND CLASSES

Leadline

Open to riders age 2-9 years old who have never shown in any class other than lead line. Leadline walk-only and walk/trot will be shown on the lead with a handler guiding the horse. Leadline off-lead walk trot will be shown off lead with the leader standing in the arena. Exhibitors will be asked to trot one short line by themselves without their leader. Riders in the leadline division are not eligible to enter any other riding classes.

Horses and riders may cross enter pleasure and in-hand divisions based on horse's eligibility. Must pre-enter for this division, no post-entries can be accepted.

Horses will be judged on their way of going and ability to give a pleasurable drive. Reinsmanship to be judged primarily on the ability and skill of the driver. Backing may be required. Rookie: Horses with no previous show experience in driving events prior to November 2021. Green: Horses that have won 6 or less blue ribbons in driving events prior to November 2021. Novice: Horses that have won 7-12 blue ribbons in driving events prior to November 2021. Senior: Horses that have won 13 or more blue ribbons in driving events prior to November 2021

Puddle Jumper

Horses to be ridden over a course of 6-8 jumps. A four-point penalty will be incurred for each refusal or jump with a rail down. Three refusals will result in an elimination. Horses with clear rounds will return to the ring for a jump-off over a shortened course. Final placings will be calculated based on jump-off score. Horses tied for other than first place will be based on their score in their first round. REMINDER: You must cross the timers at the start and finish of each course for time to be calculated. MAY NOT CROSS-ENTER JUMPER DIVISION







Western Horsemanship 2-Gait


