

The CSFP/Senior food assistance program is open to Seniors (over the age of 60) who meet the “Commodity Supplemental Food Program” (CSFP) income guidelines set by the USDA.

We do not require proof of income.

Must be a resident of Madison County to apply.

**Food Distribution Schedule: Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays: 12-4pm**

To apply, please stop by Beacon of Hope during one of our food distributions.

The initial application must be completed *in person* with Jessi.

Information required for the application process:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Physical address
- Mailing Address (if different from your physician address)
- Phone Number
- Total Monthly Income
- The name(s) of anyone you want to pick up your food, if you are unable
- Driver's License or state issued Photo ID verifying DOB

We also need the following information for each additional member of your household:

- Name
- Monthly Income

Beacon currently receives 144 food packages each month and 144 active clients enrolled.

All other eligible Seniors who enroll are added to the program's waiting list.

Program members are eligible to receive their CSFP/Senior Food Package beginning the first distribution day of each month.

The sooner members pick up their boxes, the better, as Beacon must distribute all Senior food packages by the month's end or risk losing the program.

Seniors enrolled in the program should plan on picking up their food package each month, as missing two or months in a row will result in a member being dropped from the CSFP/Senior food program (per program guidelines).

Members who are in danger of being dropped from the program will receive a letter in the mail reminding them of the program requirements.
