



## PANTERA

Sandeep's blockchain journey began with Bitcoin in 2013, but the turning point didn't come until he coded his first Ethereum dApp a few years laters. In late 2017, he joined hands with Jaynti Kanani and Anurag Arjun in creating Matic Network, the precursor of Polygon, with the goal of helping scale Ethereum. They were joined by Mihailo Bjelic in 2021 to create Polygon. A serial entrepreneur, Sandeep is also the co-founder of Sentient, an AI research organization fostering a new open AGI economy for AI builders and creators built on Polygon. Recently, Sentient secured \$85 million in a seed funding round, co-led by Peter Thiel's Founders Fund, Pantera Capital, and Framework Ventures. Sandeep holds a Master of Business Administration degree from the National Institute of Industrial Engineering. He describes himself as extremely humble, but madly ambitious.


