A scrupulous, small town non-believer with a painful past seeks comfort in a provisional priest with troubles of his own.


Synopsis

Goody follows twenty-year-old Gudelia Pedat, known to her friends and family as Goody. Brought up Catholic by her overbearing mother, Goody now unknowingly suffers from severe OCD, which manifests itself through an irrational adherence to religious rituals. After losing her faith and years after the death of her much loved, older brother Charles, she still heavily blames herself despite her lack of involvement.

As a result, she is ritualistic and has cut herself off from a normal life by sticking to a strict routine that eases her guilt and anxiety. Despite her admitted disbelief in a higher power, Goody has devoted her time to working at her small-town church under the wing of an old, harsh priest who has only guided her further into her delusions.


Goody's unhealthy routine comes to a sudden standstill when the priest suffers a stroke and winds up in the hospital, now no longer able to work. In his place, a new and much younger priest, Fr. James, is reassigned placement and brought into town in order to continue running the church as usual. Goody requests to continue working for the church only now under Fr. James's authority.

After reconnecting with her past through her childhood friend, Emma, and as her relationship with Fr. James evolves, Goody spirals to new lows and must find a way to free herself from her grief.

















MOTHER (51) - Quietly suffering with grief for her son and OCD, she drinks and smokes excessively to avoid her guilt. She's distant and often dismissive, but deep down, she recognizes the pain her daughter is dealing with.

FATHER MIKE (72) - An intense, harsh man. His career as a priest comes to a halt when he ends up in the hospital after having a stroke.

MARTHA (63) - Sweet and humble. Confused by Goody's nature.

EMMA (21) - An energetic young woman, just recently engaged. Back in town visiting her family when she bumps into an old friend from her youth. Old memories resurface.

MATTHEW (24) - Emma's cousin. Liam's brother. Party guy. Aggressive and taunting. Always looking for a fight.

LIAM (24) - Emma's cousin and Matthew's brother. Party guy. Mean and taunting.


SCOTT (22) - Engaged to Emma. Small-town guy. Likes to party, but is soft-spoken and kind.

AVA (22) - Tough girl with an attitude. Liam's girlfriend.


