



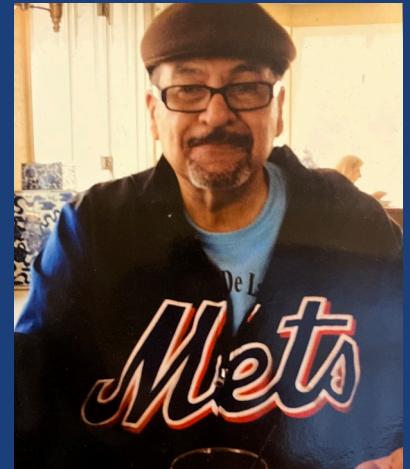
Jose Luis Kortright Scholarship

Information on criteria, application and awarding

Background

The Jose Luis Kortright Scholarship was established by Lydia, Ken, Monica, Frank, Jose, David, Larry, Denis, and Erik in honor of their husband and father. The foundation honors his passion for family, service, and commitment to the community. The Scholarship is need-based and helps support the financial need of student-athletes who would like to participate in athletic travel or after-school programming.

Applicants are selected through a process led by the Kortright family. Once awarded, the Scholarship will support the chosen applicant's choice of athletic travel or after-school program participation fee. Student-athletes may apply annually as long as they uphold the standards of academic performance and community membership outlined by The Kortright Kares Foundation. The Scholarship will be granted annually.



Criteria

The Scholarship recipients will be selected annually based on an application and essay submitted. Student athletes must meet the following criteria:

- Consistent academic performance, "Always do your best".
- Proven team player who is engaged in school and athletics with a love of learning and positive can-do attitude.
- Demonstrated financial need

How to Apply (See Attachments)

Step 1 Student-athletes in need of financial aid will be invited to apply for the Scholarship.

Step 2 Applicants need to request a reference letter from either a teacher, advisor, or coach describing their engagement in and out of the classroom. (Only one reference letter is required. See attachment for reference letter form.)

Step 3 Applicants complete an essay articulating what qualifies them for the scholarship. (See attached) "Mr. Kortright dedicated himself to a life of service always with a positive attitude, commitment to community and family. Describe a situation that you have encountered when you had to make a decision that demonstrated your commitment to school and your community."

Step 4 Applicant submits all application materials to The Kortright Kares Foundation via email. (All submitted applications will receive a confirmation email)
