Organizational Overview

The Louisiana Abortion Fund (formerly the New Orleans Abortion) Fund) is a community fund that assists in overcoming the economic and geographic barriers erected to prevent them from accessing abortion care.

By providing low-barrier financial support for abortions and support for travel and childcare, we are investing in our community's liberation. We work to center Black people, Indigenous communities, people of color, queer folks, and immigrants because we know that when the most marginalized among us are free, we will all be free.



Organizational Overview

Our work is rooted in the principles of reproductive justice as defined by Sister Song as "the human right to maintain personal bodily autonomy, have children, not have children, and parent the children we have in safe and sustainable communities."

As a Black-led organization in the Deep South in a post-Roe landscape, we recognize that the barriers to abortion care were too high and too many long before the Supreme Court's most recent ruling. We envision a world where everyone has access to the healthcare they determine is right for them, and those who decide to raise children can raise them in a world free from state violence and the violence of poverty, patriarchy, white supremacy, and queerphobia.

Organizational Updates

Over the last two years, we have embarked on a journey of transformation to build the kind of organization our communities deserve. We have:

- Restructured and rebuilt our board and staff so that it is more representative of the folks LAAF serves. Our majority-Black staff is working to ground the organization in a reproductive justice framework, and is dedicated to ensuring the safety and well-being of clients, staff, and volunteers.
- Transitioned from a mostly volunteer organization to an organization that compensates its workers and provides the time necessary for staff to care for their physical, mental, and emotional needs.
- Distributed more direct abortion support funds than in 2020 and 2021
- Officially changed our name to Louisiana Abortion Fund to deepen our commitment to supporting the bodily autonomy of all Louisianans, including those in rural corners of the state who face even more barriers to accessing the care they determine is right for them.

Abortion Access Landscape Overview

Since the Dobbs decision, abortion has been fully banned in the three states our callers traveled to most frequently in 2021 (LA, TX, and MS.)

While many of our callers are able to access care as nearby as Florida or Georgia, these states have banned care at 15 and 6 weeks, respectively. The majority of our funded callers are traveling much further for care to places like Illinois, New Mexico, and DC. Several callers have even traveled as far as 3,800 miles roundtrip from their homes in Louisiana to providers in California. This is compared to our callers traveling just over 260 miles roundtrip for care in 2021.

Of our thirty closest clinic partners we worked with this year prior to the Dobbs decision, **30% have now closed or stopped performing abortions.** Another 10% and 20% are limited to providing care up to 6 and 15 weeks, respectively.

Thank you to Women's Health Care Center, Hope Medical Group, and Delta Clinic of Baton Rouge who together provided necessary abortion care to thousands of people in our communities each year prior to the Dobbs decision. Our Louisiana clinic partners have shut their doors, but they are not forgotten.










