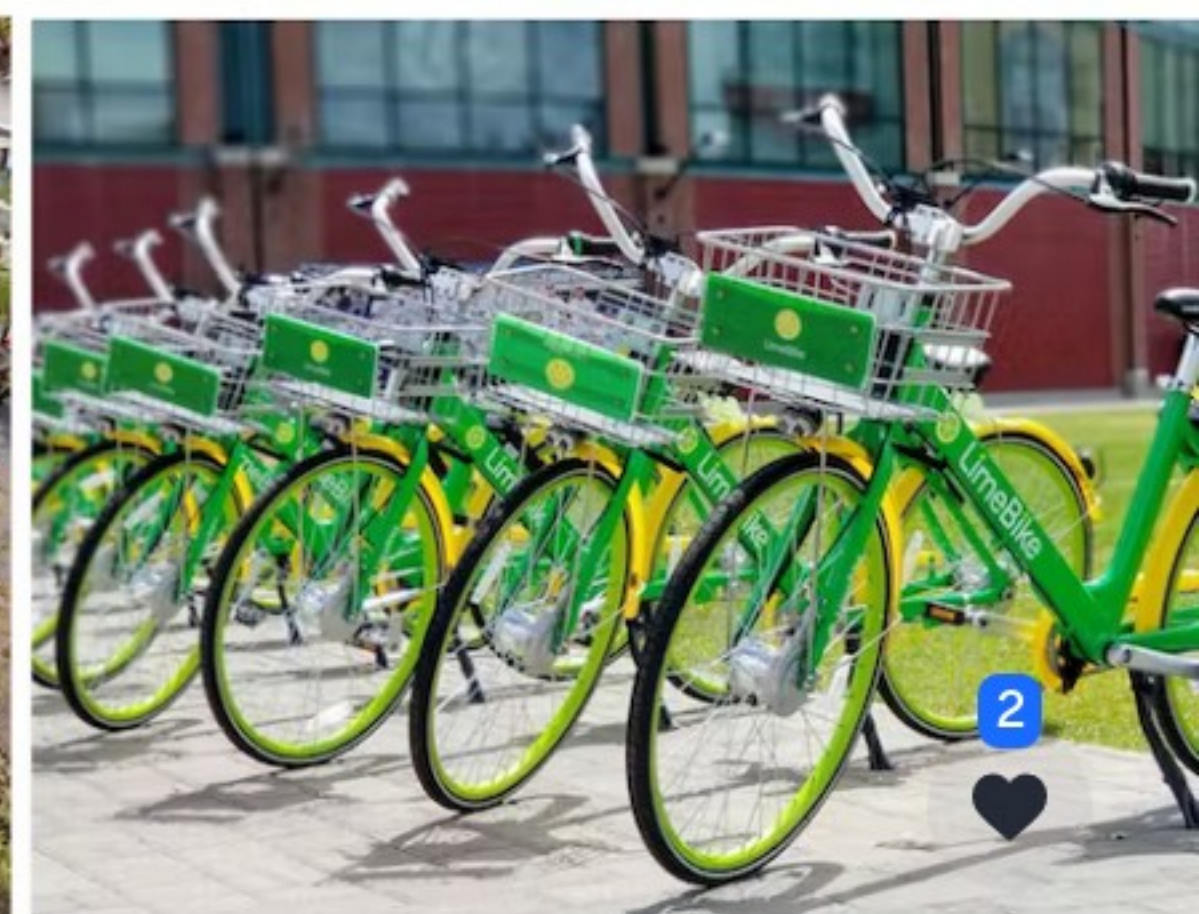

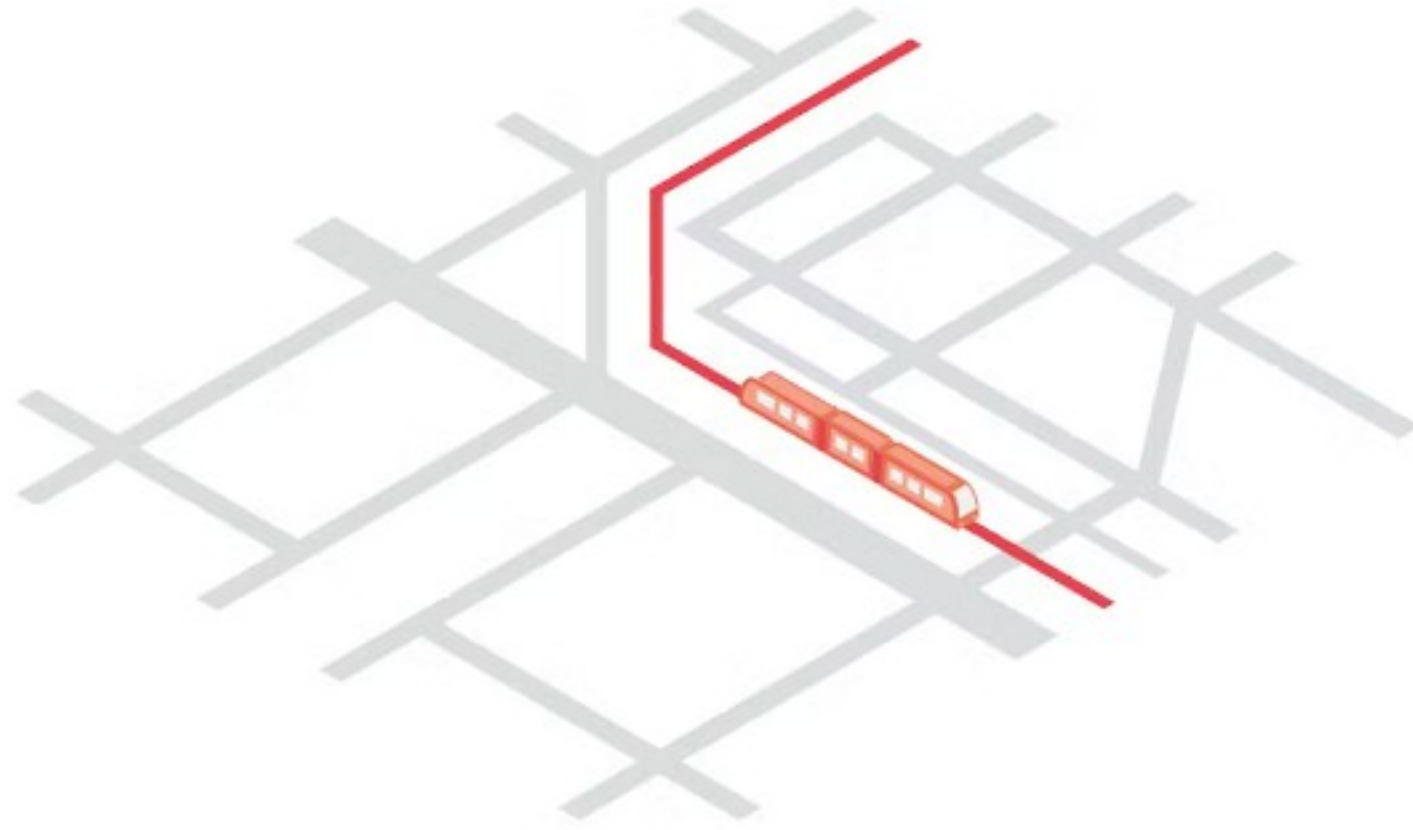

Transit (Transportation)

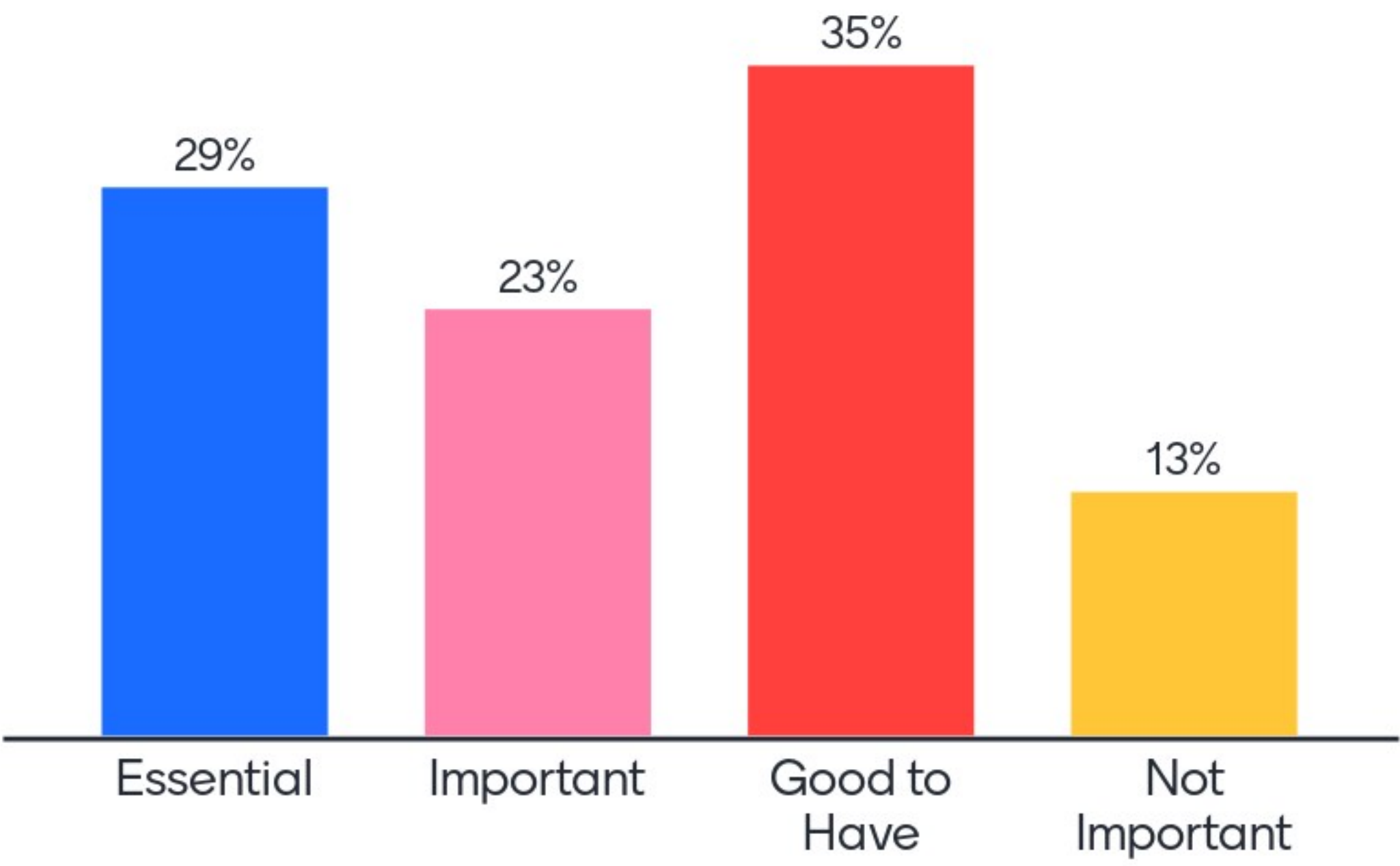

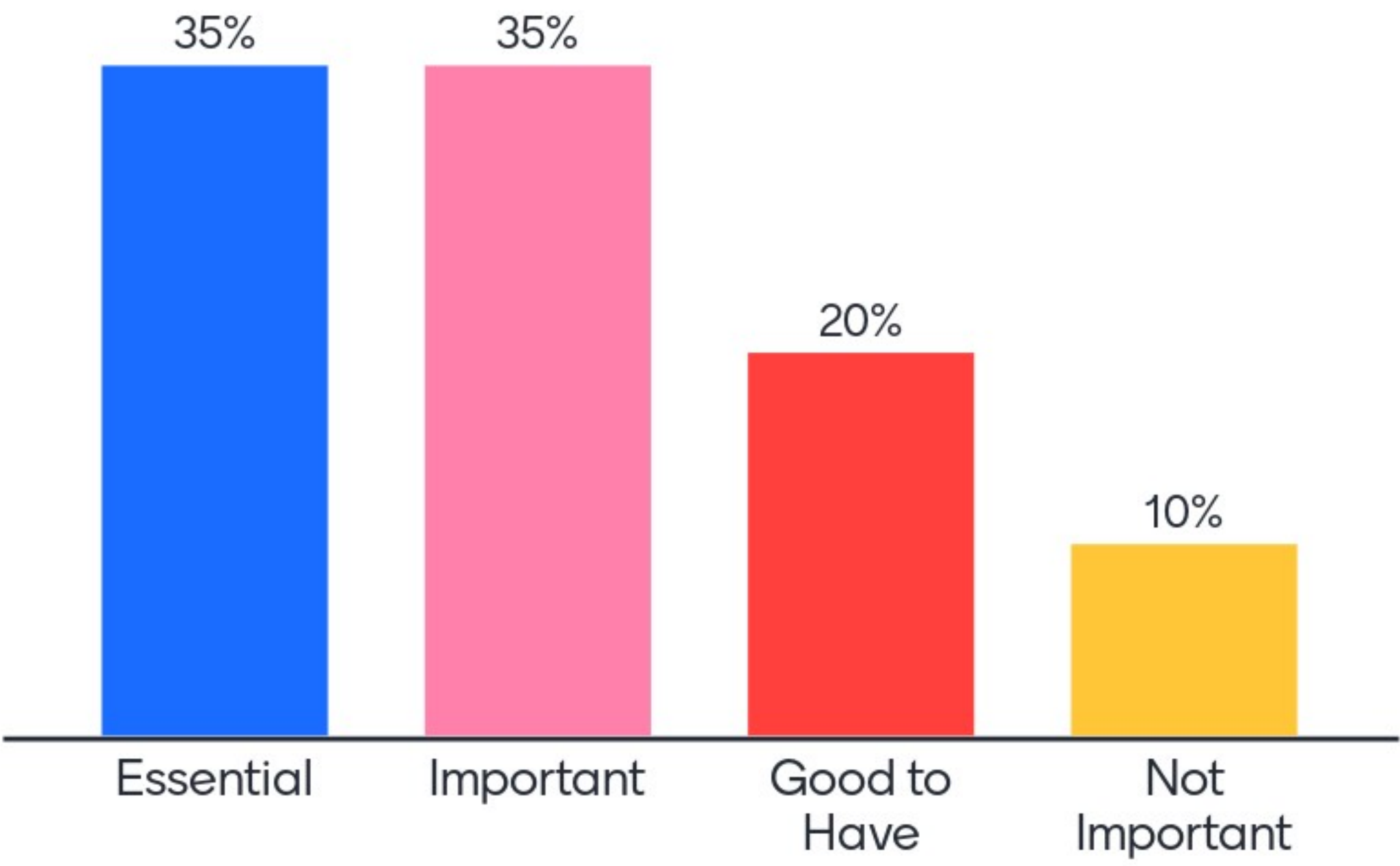
The Payson Station Area should include... Bike Parking & Storage

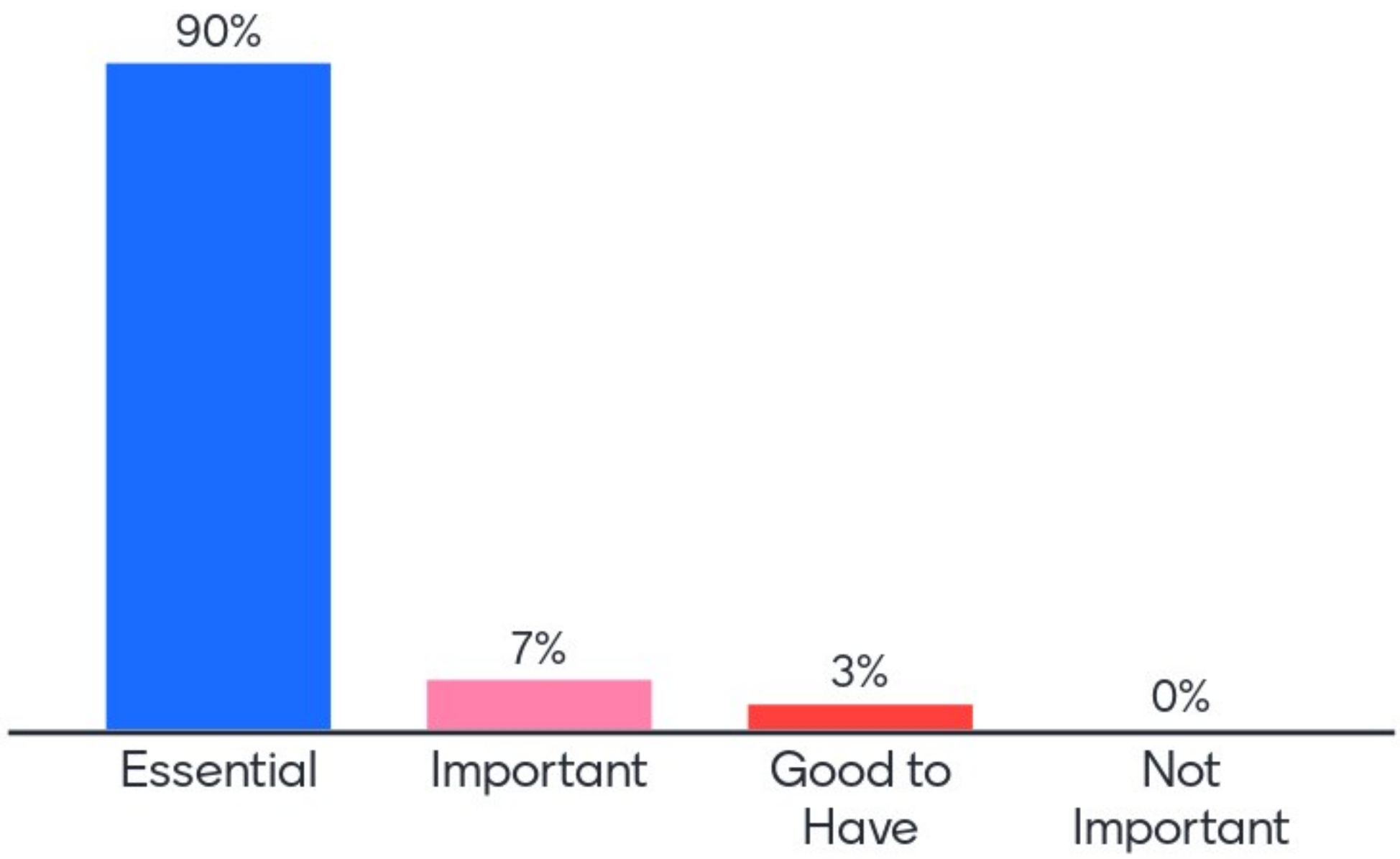
The Payson Station Area should include... Park and Ride Garage

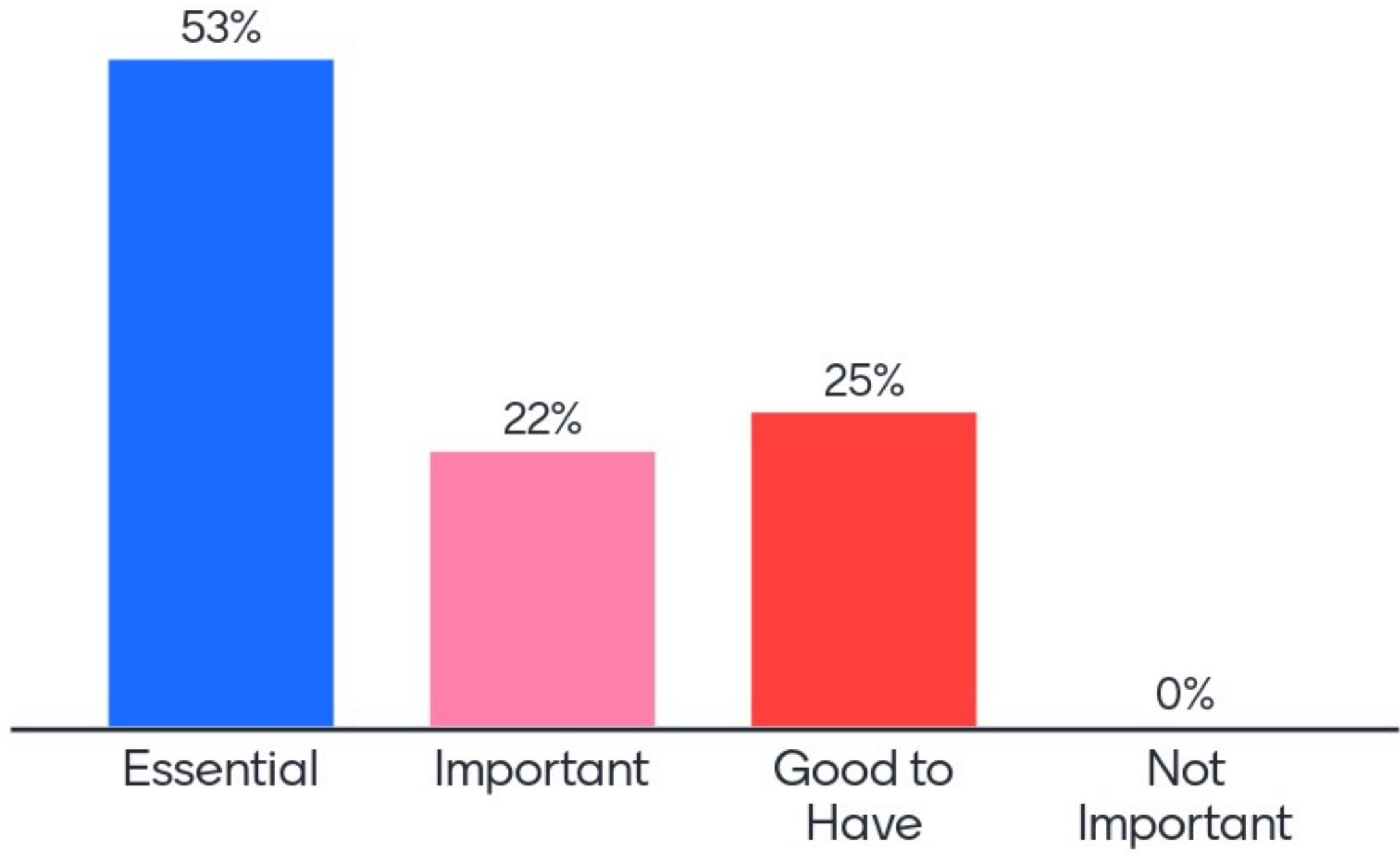
The Payson Station Area should include... Bus Service connecting the Train Station to Greater Payson

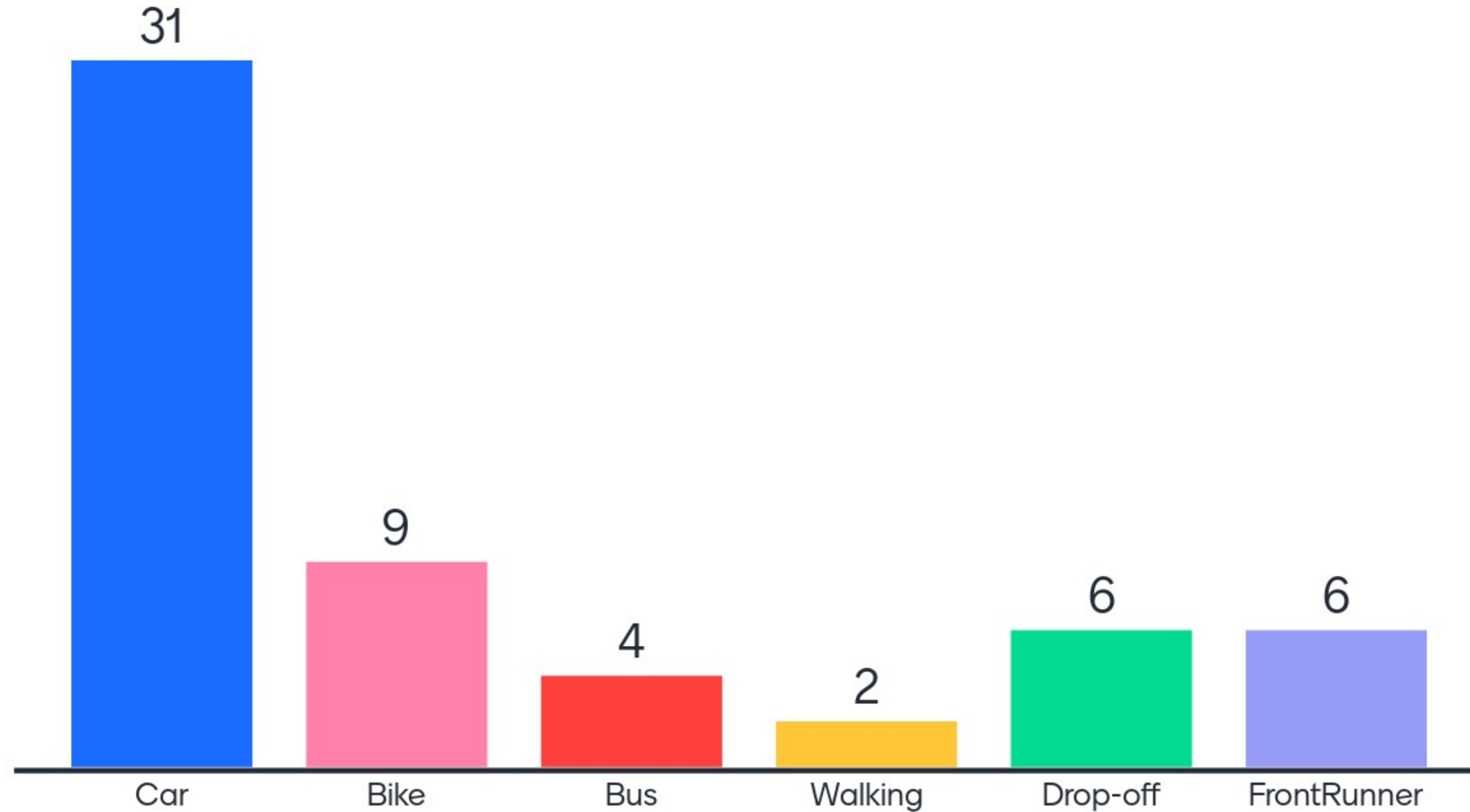


The Payson Station Area should include... Information Signs & Kiosks

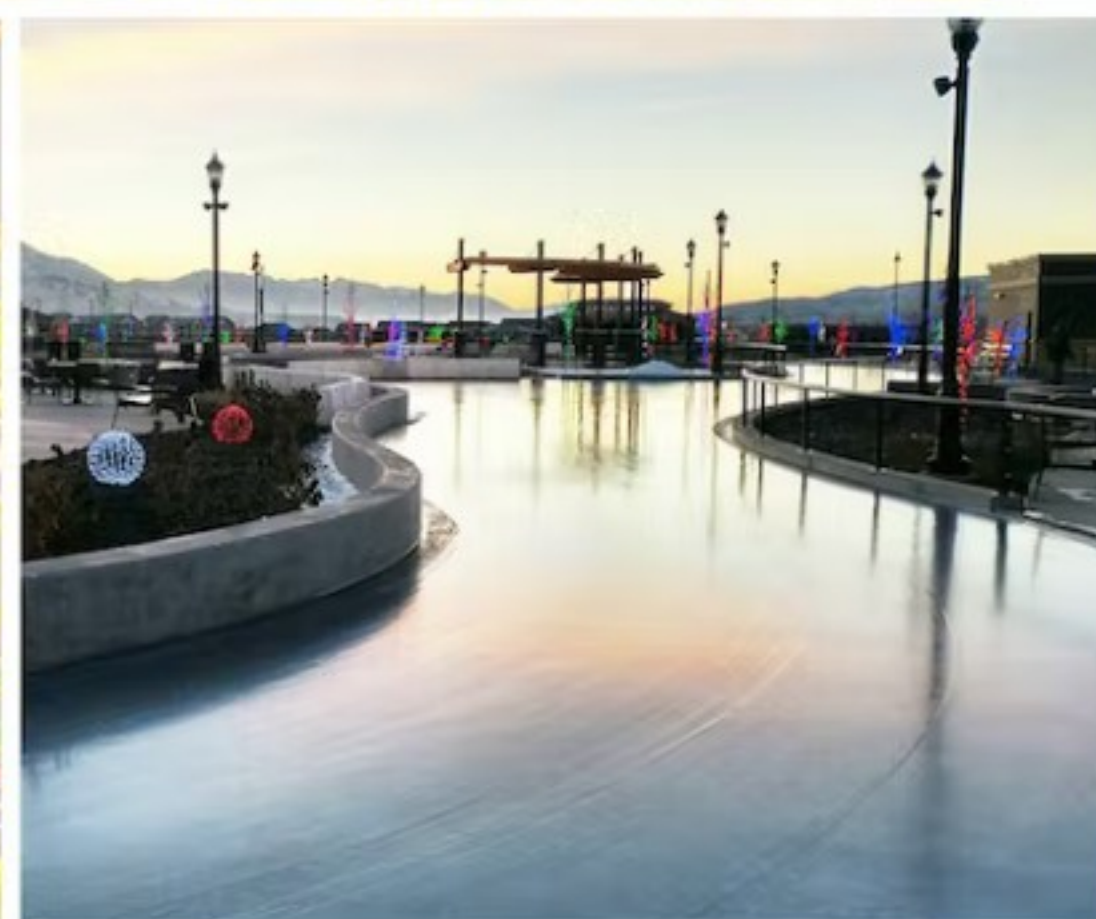


Oriented (Open Space)

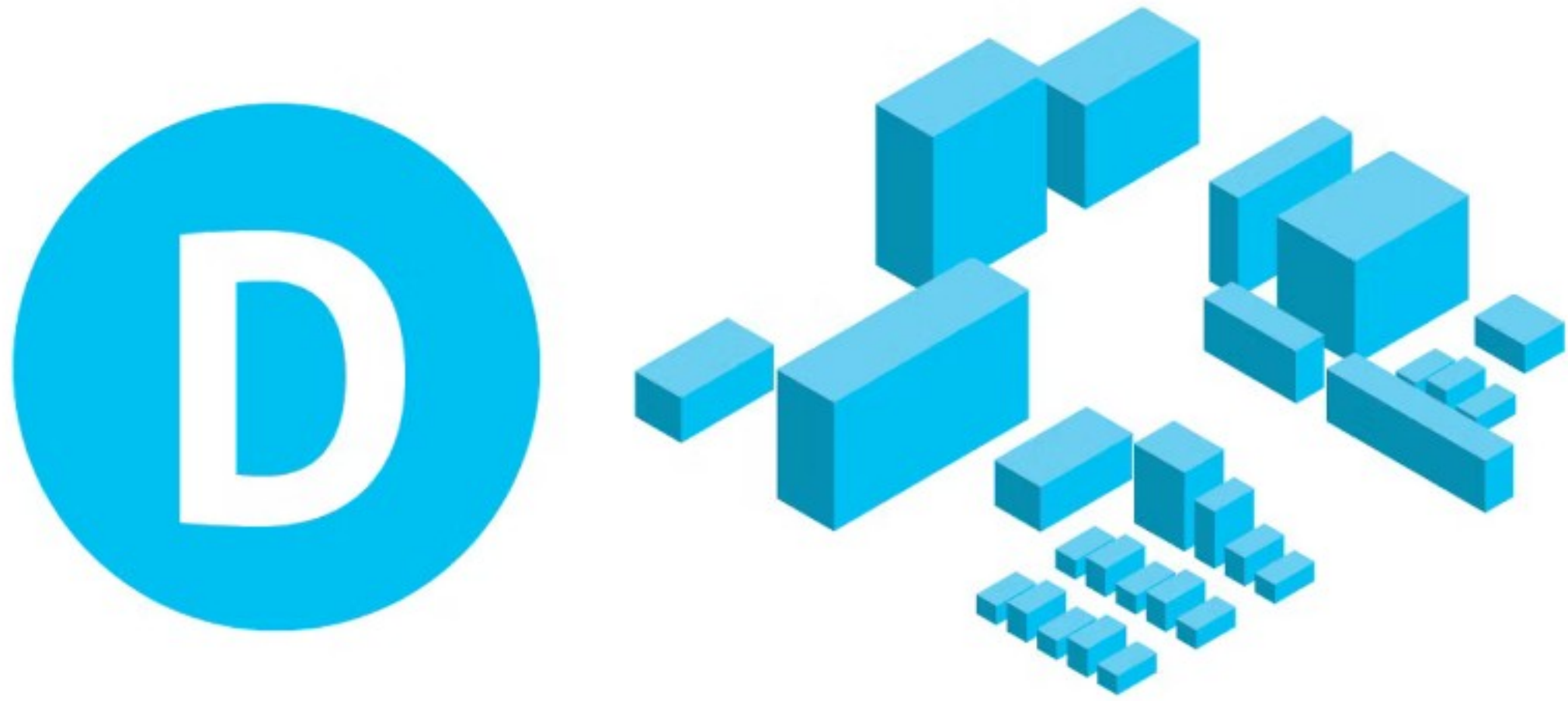




What outdoor amenities should be included in the Payson Station area?

Development (Buildings)

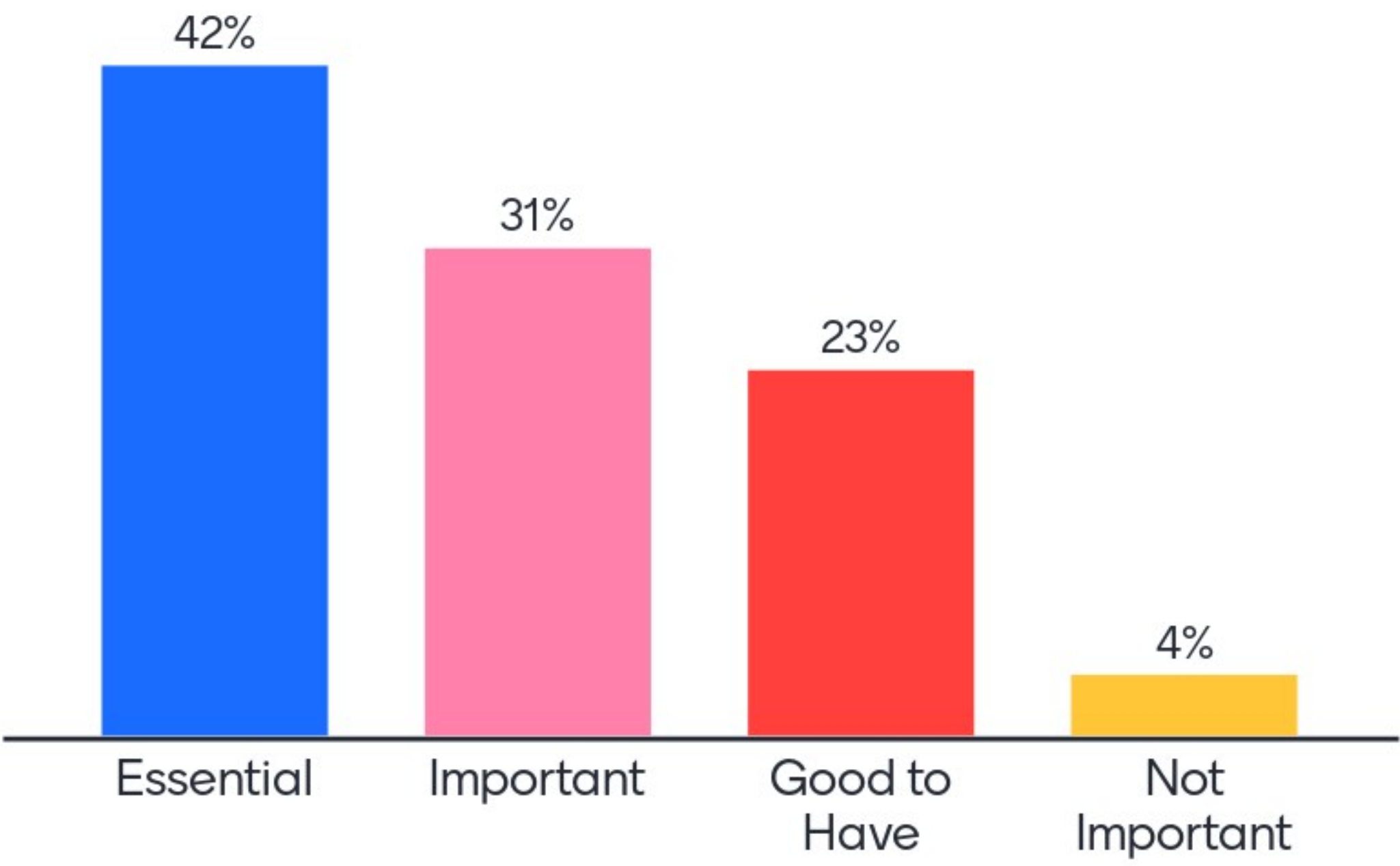

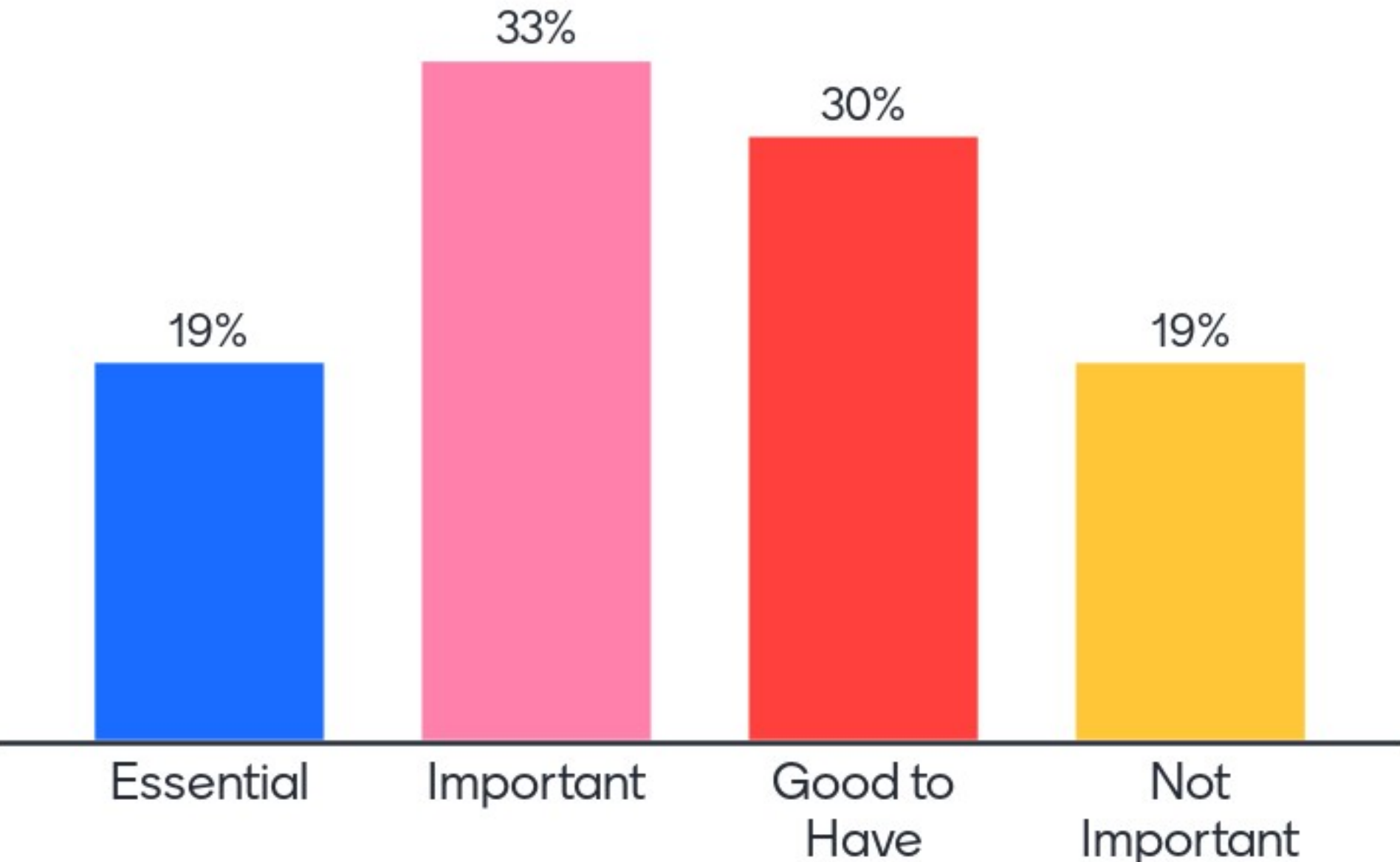

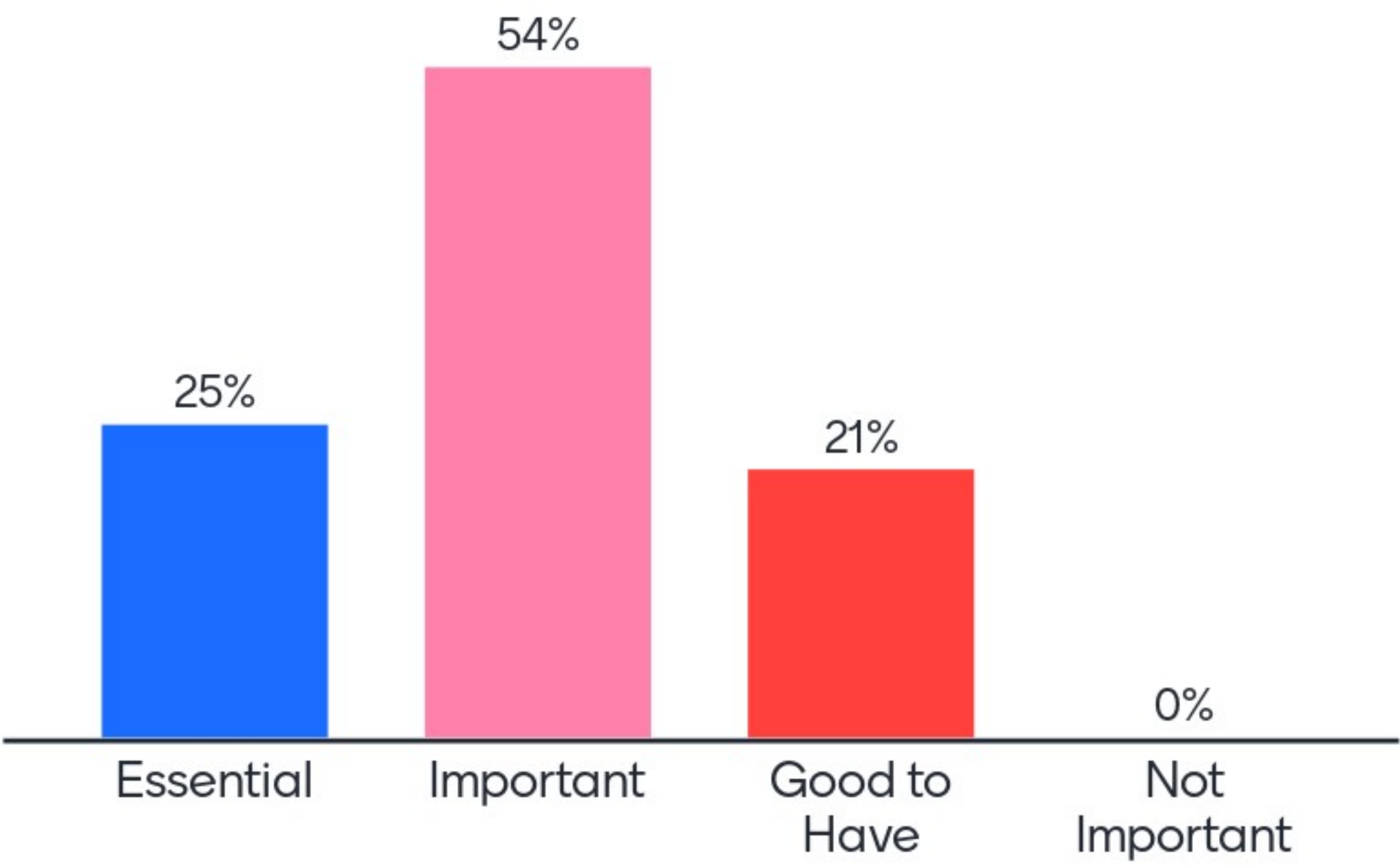

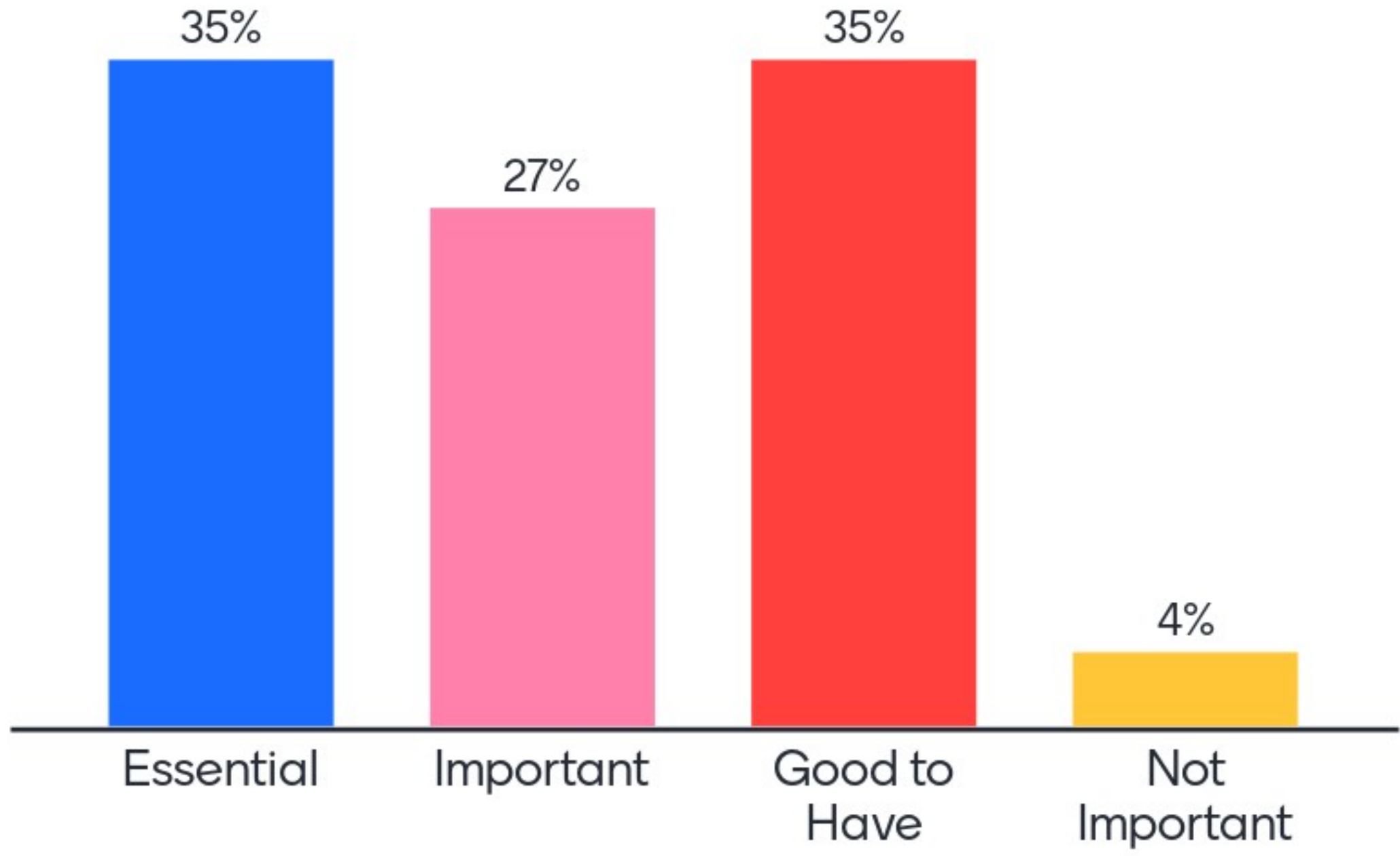

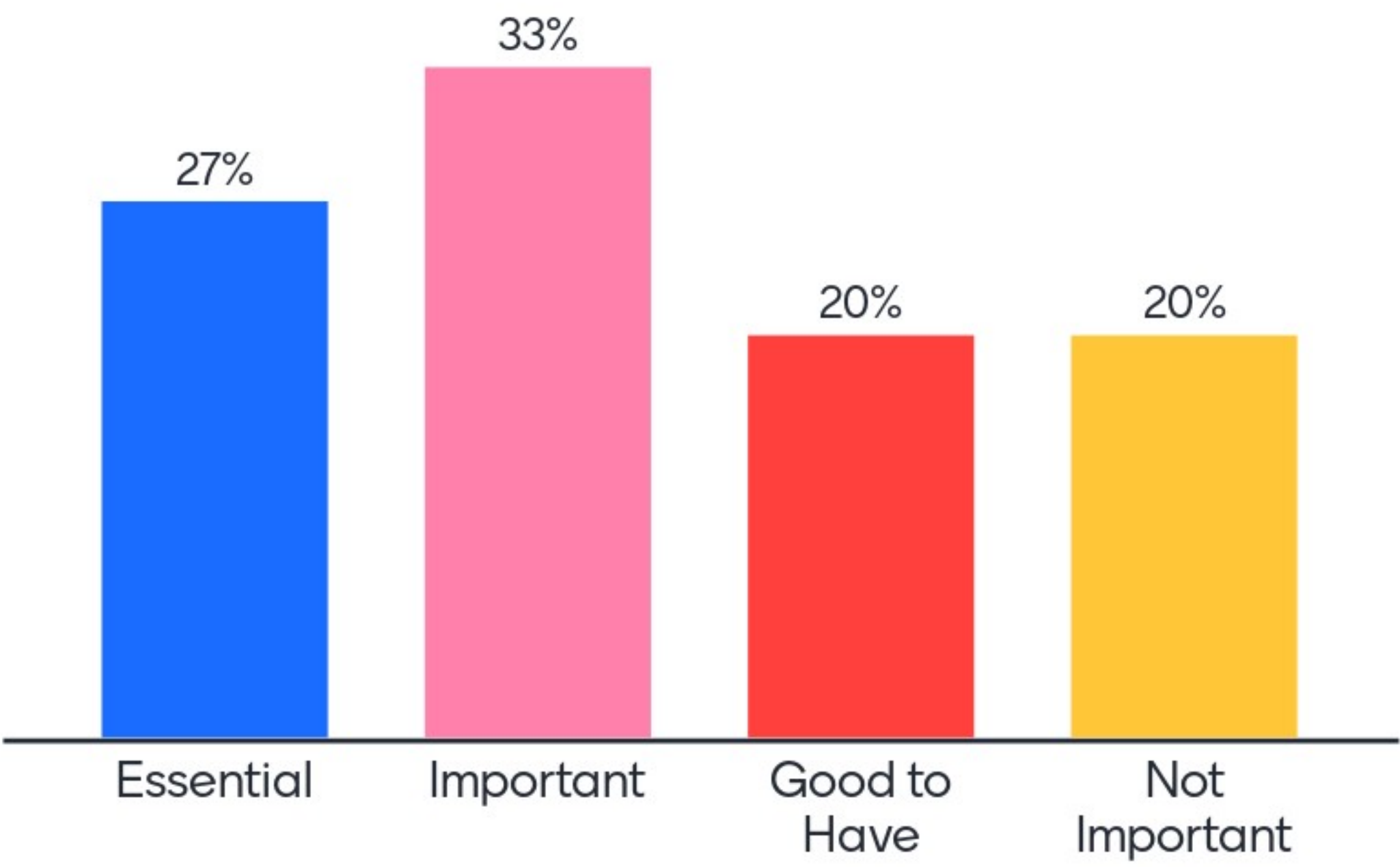

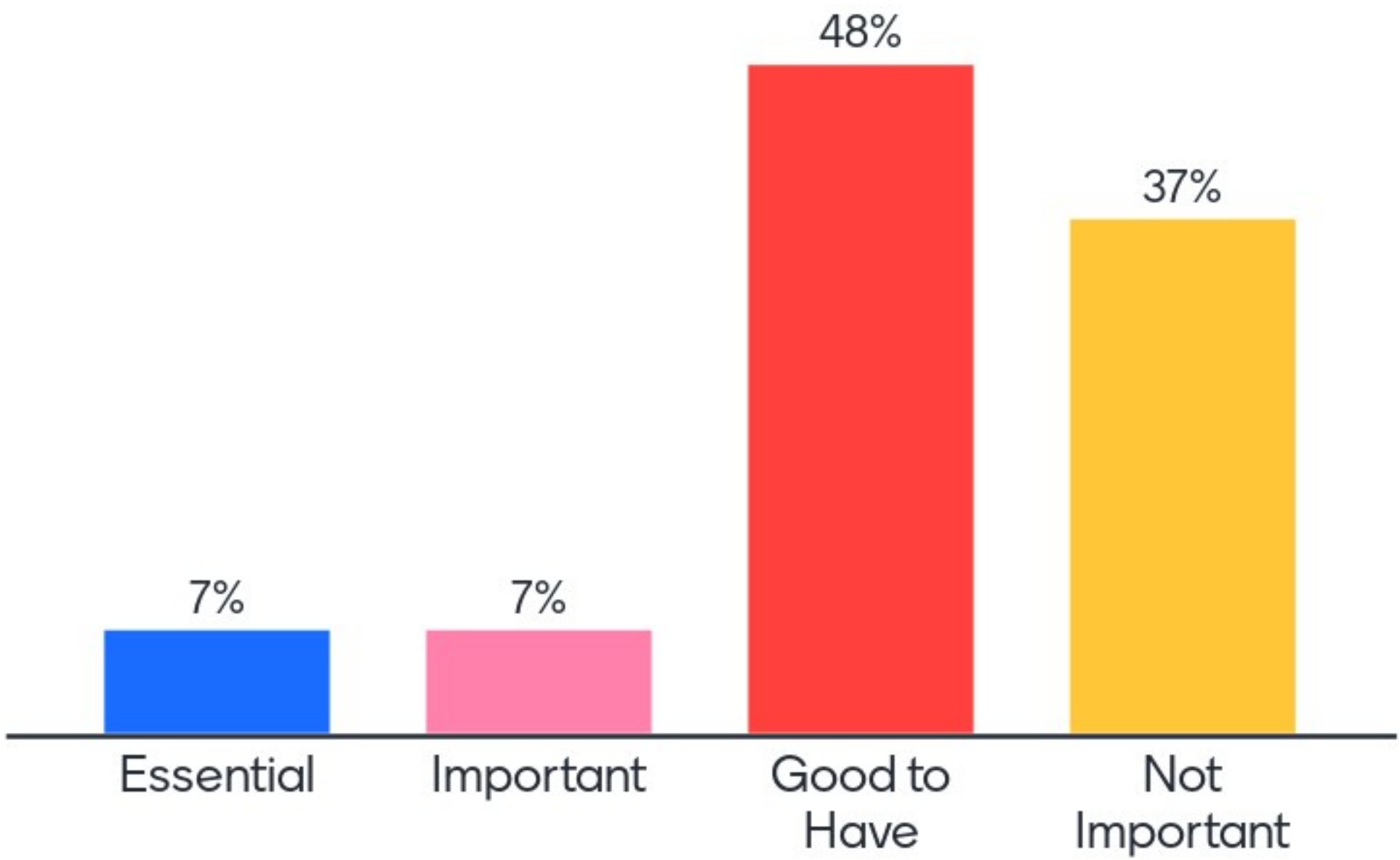
