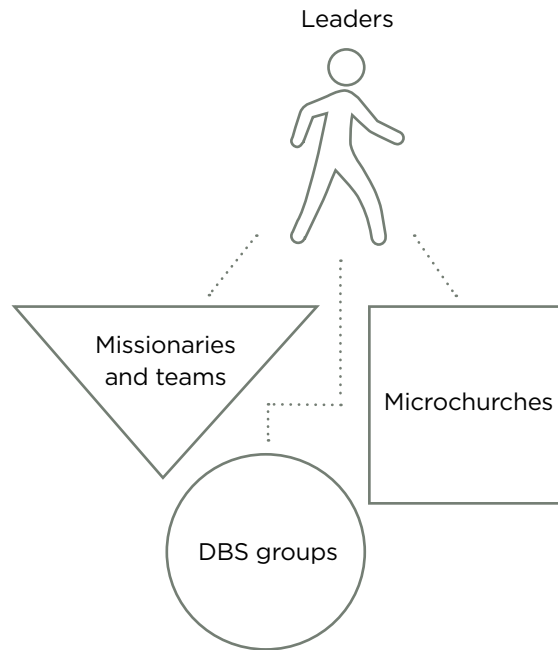


# The What and How of Multiplication

## 1 Multiply New Teams of Everyday Missionaries in New Contexts

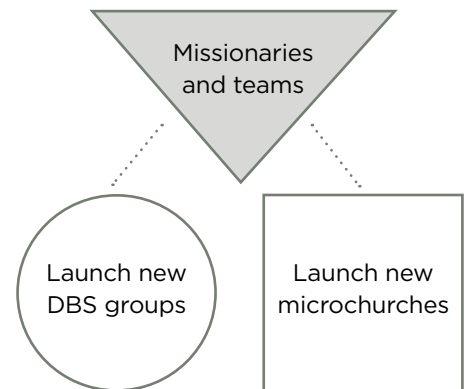
These teams can start new DBS groups and microchurches.

- Recruit believers and train them to reach their already existing contexts.
- Identify a context and form a team to engage that context.

### Look for:

- the holy discontented ones - those who are itching to live with purpose or reach out
- those who have a specific heart for a specific cause or group of people
- New followers of Jesus eager to tell their people the Good News!
- People from already existing microchurches who share a heart for a new context



## 2 Multiply by Launching New Discovery Group Environments

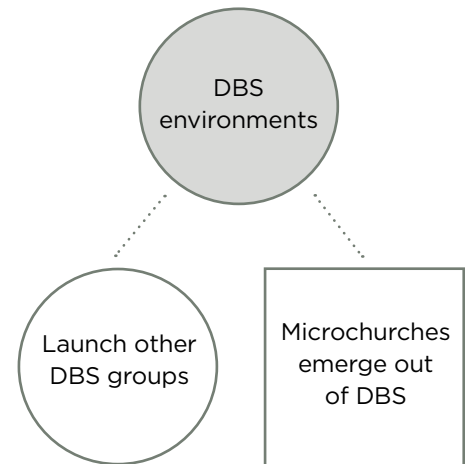
These can launch new DBS groups and microchurches.

- Plant the Gospel in a context and make disciples via the [Discovery Bible Study](#) process.
- Encourage all participants in DBS groups to start their own group with others.

#### Look for:

- spiritually open people in your relational contexts willing to discover more about what God says about life
- those willing to obey and live out their I WILL statements
- those with other relational circles



## 3 Multiply by launching new microchurches

These can launch new teams, DBS groups, and other microchurches.

- Encourage and train the members to missionally engage their other relational networks.
- Launch new teams out of your microchurch.
- If your microchurch grows too large, raise up new leadership, and form a second group.
