Accessibility Guide

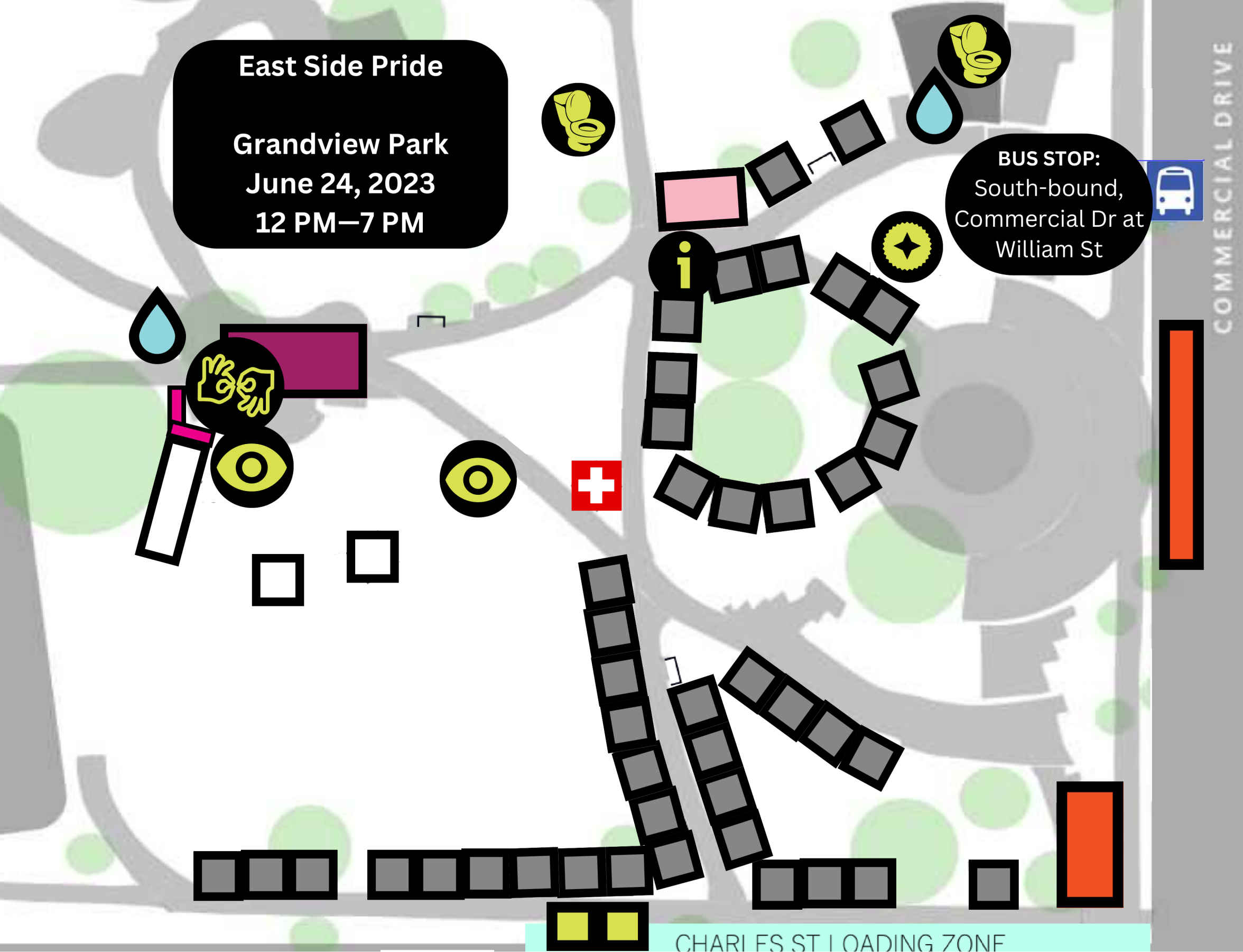
- **Low Sensory tent** is located at the Northeast corner of the park facilitated by Learn, Educate, Transform, Society. Low sensory decompression space with activities and sensory support will be available at our tent.
- **Service Animals** are permitted on site.
- **Scent Reduction Policy** is in effect. Avoid wearing perfume and strong scents as much as possible.
- **Masks** are not required, but available at the Information Booth for those who want them.
- **Accessible pathways** are along the site. Please note there are areas of uneven ground and gentle slopes.
- **ASL Interpreters** are available at the south corner of the stage.
- **Accessible Toilets** are available at the park.
- **Viewing Zones** are available in front of the stage and by a path; they are reserved for those with access need. Priority given for Deaf, Hard of Hearing, Blind, Low Vision, and those requiring interpreters in front of the stage.
- **Designated Assistants** are available at our Information Booth and Viewing Zones.
- **Food Options** available for dietary restrictions including: Vegetarian, Vegan, Dairy Free, Gluten Free, Egg Free, Peanut Free, Treenut Free, Sesame Free, and Seafood Free.
