Personal Information:

- Provide full name, email, phone, and address.
- Include university, major, expected graduation date, and GPA.

Internship Details:

- Indicate preferred start and end dates.
- Choose internship type (semester/summer).
- Specify weekly availability.

Project Proposal:

Create a detailed project proposal including:

- 1. Project Title: Give your project a concise and descriptive title.
- 2. Project Description: Explain the purpose, goals, and expected outcomes of your proposed project.
- 3. Project Timeline: Outline the key milestones and deadlines for your project.
- 4. Methodology: Describe how you plan to approach and execute the project.
- 5. Skills and Resources: List any skills, tools, or resources you will need to complete the project.
- 6. Benefits to the Welcome Center: Explain how the project will benefit the Welcome Center and its mission.
- 7. Challenges and Mitigation: Anticipate any challenges you may encounter and how you plan to address them.
