- 3. If you are shipping your horse in for the weekend, add the "Ship In Fee" when entering
- 4. Tack stalls can be ordered directly onto horses or onto the barn account (which is automatically created) and can be split when you check in for the show
- 5. For those planning to show FEI, please add the FEI stall option to your entry when it is created.

Cost

- 1. \$300 per stall, tack room, or grooming stall (\$225 for Summer 2)
- 2. This fee includes Equine Night Security

Deadline

- 1. Stalls are non-refundable after the closing date of each show
- 2. Stalls are on a first come first served basis. Some weeks will be limited on number of stalls available
- 3. If permanent stalls are filled, temporary stalls may be used

Cancellations

- 1. Stalls canceled after the closing date are non-refundable

Shavings/Hay

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4)

classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Tryon Horse Shows, Tryon International Equestrian Center, & Tryon Resort (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensa- tion, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of

New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings and rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication, the USEF, Tryon Horse Shows, Tryon International Equestrian Center, Equus Events, Inc. and its management and/or employees assume no liability to anyone for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted upon their acceptance, and otherwise in accordance with USEF rules.

SAFESPORT REMINDER: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the US Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the US Center SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

MICROCHIPS: All horses and ponies must be microchipped in order to be allowed to show. Exempt from this requirement are Walk-Trot and Opportunity entries and those others listed in USEF GR 901.

SCHEDULES: All Schedules are Tentative and subject to change. Updated schedules and daily schedules are available at www.tryon.com.

PRIZE LISTS: Prize Lists can be found on www.tryon.com website. Hard copies will be mailed on request.

ENTRIES: Entries must be made online by the closing dates in order to avoid a late fee. Faxed, scanned and/or e-mailed entries will not be accepted. All entries must be secured with a credit card.

CLOSING DATES for entries are as follows:

- Summer 2 JUNE 12, 2023 Summer 3 - JUNE 12, 2023 Summer 4 - JUNE 19, 2023 Summer 5 - JUNE 26, 2023
- Summer 6 JULY 3, 2023

After the closing date, stall fees are non-refundable. A \$50 Late Fee will apply for all entries not made online by the closing dates. Entries should be submitted via our online entry system at www.tryon.com or

www.showgroundslive.com. Back numbers will not be issued without credit card information logged with the Horse Show Secretary. A \$60 (Summer 2) and \$75 (Summer 3-6) Office Fee will be charged to each horse entered into the show to cover adds/scratches, office services, etc. The entry form for each horse must include the following:

- Horse name and complete description
- Complete mailing addresses for owner/trainer/riders

• All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibitor

• All required organization membership numbers,

USEF/USHJA horse registration numbers and microchip numbers

- All horses/ponies on property will be assessed a mandatory
- \$20 Medical/Vet Services Fee per competition
- Equine Night Security is included in the stall fee

All riders participating in amateur or adult classes must be

in possession of current amateur status issued by USEF, or apply for same at show

• Entries/post entries accepted based on stall availability

SCRATCHES: Horses may be scratched without a veterinarian's certificate by notifying the horse show secretary in writing. Prior to the closing date, all charges will be refunded (except prepaid stall). After the closing date, stalls are non-refundable and horses will be charged a \$65 scratch fee. No refunds to horses entered in classes not shown.

RETURNED CHECKS/DISPUTED CARDS: A \$75 fee will be charged for non-negotiable checks or credit cards declined or disputed for any reason. Entries for future shows may be declined until funds are paid in full. For any trainers, riders, owners, or responsible parties that have disputed a credit card charge or submitted an NSF check, pre-payment will be required for stalls and entries prior to the start of the show.

SHOW INVOICES: All accounts must be closed out by Sunday of each show week. If you do not, you automatically agree to authorize Tryon Horse Shows to charge the credit card on file for all entry fees, stabling fees, association fees, etc. associated with your horse(s) and are subject to a \$10 close out fee per horse. If you dispute a charge made by Tryon Horse Shows, you may not be able to show until the dispute has been resolved. Invoice discrepancies must be reported to the show office within 24 hours of the completion of the last class of the show. After this time invoices are considered finalized.

OFFICE HOURS:

DAY BEFORE FIRST DAY OF SHOW - 8:00AM-4:00PM SHOW DAYS - ONE HOUR BEFORE FIRST CLASS - 4:00PM SUNDAY - THE OFFICE WILL CLOSE 30 MINUTES AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE LAST CLASS.

CLASS DECLARATIONS: Class adds due by 4:00pm the day before the class (except classes with 24-hr check in). Scratches may be made in the office or online before the class starts. Horses not scratched prior to the start of the class will be billed for that class. Hunter Classic entries are due before the start of the 1st round. Management reserves the right to cut off adds to classes prior to 4pm in the event of weather or ring time restrictions.

STALLS: All stalls are non-transferable and remain under the ownership and control of Tryon International Equestrian Center. Permanent 10x12 stalls of wood/metal construction and temporary 10x10 stall of canvas/metal construction with doors. Flooring is rubber mats over stone dust. Stalls are available for \$300 (Summer 3-6), \$225 (Summer 2). Locking tack stalls are also available at the regular stall price. Stalls are not refundable after the closing date. To ensure stabling as well as your initial bedding/feed orders, please complete an online entry at Tryon.com. Any horse showing in classes that fall under the '24 Hour Rule' must have an unshared, assigned stall and will be assessed a stall fee. Non-stabled horses will pay a \$50 Grounds Fee.

STABLING ARRIVALS: Will be available starting at 1:00 pm the day before Schooling Day. Check schedules for Schooling Day. Any and all requests for early arrival/late departure must be approved by the Stabling Manager. Early arrivals/late departures will incur a charge of \$50 per stall per day (or any portion thereof).

PRIZE MONEY & REFUNDS: Social Security or Federal ID number of owner or alternate prize money recipient are required for prize money to be distributed. No prize money will be applied until Tax ID#s and complete payee names/addresses/W-9's are on file with the Secretary. Prize money will be credited to your show account once a tax ID/W9 is on file. Any overages (over payment or prize money remaining) will be mailed within 30 days of the close of the competition. In the event of unauthorized redeeming of a check, Tryon Horse Shows, LLC will provide check copies to exhibitors and will be held harmless from the collection process. Prize money will not be applied or distributed unless a w-9 with tax ID is on file. For foreign prize money recipients, an 8ben must be submitted. Per US government regulation, 30% of winnings will be withheld on foreign prize money recipients.

FEI STALLS: Permanent 10x12 stalls of wood/metal

construction. One stall per each FEI horse is included in the FEI Event Fee. Additional FEI stalls, if available, are \$350. FEI STABLING: Will be available as per FEI draft schedule. Any and all requests for early arrival/late departure must be approved by the Stabling Manager. Early arrivals/late departures will incur a charge of \$50 per stall per day (or any portion thereof). FEI - please refer to FEI page herein.

REQUIRED HEALTH DOCUMENTS: Upon arrival at the main gate, horses must be presented with a negative coggins within one year, proof of EHV1 and EHV4 vaccinations within 6 months, and out-of-state horses must have a 30-day interstate Health Certificate.

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Sharps Containers are available in the barns

TRAINER SPLITS: Trainer Splits are done as a courtesy and must be turned into the Horse Show Office by 12:00 noon on Friday. Any trainer accounts which have not been split, for any reason, will be evenly split on all horses entered into the horse show.

TICKETED SCHOOLING: If time and weather permits, management may make ticketed schooling available for \$30 per round. Back number and a signed entry blank are required. Time limits may apply. Switching riders or horses leaving and returning to the ring are susceptible to being billed for a second round.

LODGING: Please contact our Lodging Department at 828-863-1015 to inquire about available onsite/offsite lodging options, reserve a room, cabin or camper/ RV site or golf cart. All reservations and payment for all reservations must be made directly to the Lodging Department. Campers/RVs/cabins, etc. may NOT be put on show bills, nor split on Trainer Accounts.

MINORS/MINOR EXHIBITORS: Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minors/minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian, or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hoverboards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

RINGS: All competition/riding rings have all-weather footing that consists of sand and synthetic material mixture and draining system. Rings 1-4 178'x390' each; Tryon Stadium 310'x250'; Ring 6/7 370'x420', Ring 8 150'x691'; International Arena 260'x325'; Longeing Area 420'x115'.

COURSES: Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle, if deemed necessary, by a mandatory line ("dotted line") as per HU110.2.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise contained at all times. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR1301.6. Failure to maintain your dog under control, as defined here, will result in a \$100 fine assessed to the owner. In addition, pursuant to facility regulations, loose dogs will be removed from the show grounds by Animal Control, at the owner's expense and impounded.

PARKING: Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or off-load. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

ANIMAL WELFARE: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds,, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well-being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF

rules. IN THE EVENT OF AN ACUTE AND SERIOUS INJURY TO OR ILLNESS OF A HORSE ON COMPETITION GROUNDS WHEN THE OWNER OR TRAINER OF THE HORSE OR AGENT OF THE OWNER IS NOT PRESENT, AFTER REASONABLE EFFORT TO CONTACT THAT INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN MADE, COMPETITION MANAGEMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH A LICENSED EQUINE VETERINARIAN, MAY AUTHORIZE THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCE VETERINARY TREATMENT OF THE HORSE. IF COMPETITION MANAGEMENT SO AUTHORIZES TREATMENT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS RULE, COMPETITION MANAGEMENT AND VETERINARIAN ARE NOT LIABLE FOR ANY RESULTING COSTS, DAMAGES, LOSSES, CLAIM OR ACTIONS ARISING DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY FROM THE TREATMENT OF THE HORSE.

ELECTRICAL/FIRE REGULATIONS: All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles will be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in the aisles. No Class 1 Flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within the stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse.

MEASUREMENTS: Measurements will be conducted at 10am on Friday of each show. If an alternate measure time is needed, the exhibitor should schedule this in the show office.

HEADGEAR: All persons when mounted anywhere on the showgrounds are required to wear properly fastened protective headgear. Please refer to GR801.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES/GOLF CARTS: Under North Carolina State Laws and USEF rules, unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles - ATV's, motorcycles, golf carts, etc., on the show grounds. Failure to

abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show. See USEF GR 1301.7.

LIABILITY: Tryon Horse Shows, LLC, Tryon International Equestrian Center, Equestrian Sports Productions, their officials, and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectators, guest, rider, groom, attendant, other employees, animals, or equipment at the events. All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third persons caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, their horses, or their dogs. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events, and to keep that policy up to date. 

RIDER: A rider in the Adult Amateur section is not eligible to compete in any class where fence heights exceed 3'3" with the exception of the Children's/Adult Jumpers and the USHJA National Hunter Derby. 

Membership/Participation Requirements

A. Riders, Owners and Trainers must be current Active members of USEF and USHJA before the start of the championship. (see GR202)

B. Horses must be recorded with the Federation and registered with USHJA to participate in the championship.

C. Exception: Foreign residents and horses in good standing with their National Federation are eligible to compete in this class. However, the points and/or money won will not count for any USEF or USHJA standings or awards unless they are also members of USEF and USHJA, and the horse is recorded with USEF and registered with USHJA.

D. The same horse may not compete in the USHJA National Hunter Derby Regional Championship and the International Hunter Derby at the same competition.

E. Horses entered in this class are not required to show in any other classes at the horse show.

F. Riders are limited to competing no more than four (4) horses in the championship, however, a competition may choose to further limit the number of horses a rider can compete to three (3) horses, as long as the competition notifies the USHJA sixty (60) days in advance of the date of the class and such limitation is printed in the prize list.

G. In accordance with HU174.14 the same horse-and-rider combination must compete in both rounds of the National Hunter Derby Championship.

H. Horses may not be cross entered in multiple sections of the National Hunter Derby Regional Championship.

I. Attire: Refer to HU107 in the USEF Rule Book for current specifications. J. Horses may compete in one (1) regional championship of the exhibitor's choice per year.

Competition Format

The USHJA National Hunter Derby Regional Championship will be composed two (2) rounds: Classic Hunter Style Round and Handy Hunter Round. If required, a Jump-off Round will be held.

1. The National Hunter Derby Championship Classic Hunter Style Round consists of the entered horses present for this event. These horses will compete over a Classic Hunter Course.

Horse Inspection

1. Championship horses must be stabled on the show grounds, in official horse show stabling starting no later than two hours prior to the horse inspection and remaining on the show grounds until the completion of their championship. (Minus extenuating circumstances)

2. Horses competing in the championship may not compete in any other class at the same horse show after the Official horse inspection has taken place. Exception: Official 1.00/1.05m USHJA Championship Training class.

3. All championship horses must be presented at the mandatory horse inspection by the athlete or a designated representative. The horse inspection will be held not more than 24 hours prior to the start of the First Individual Qualifying Class.

4. If the athlete is unable to attend the horse inspection, a designated representative who is 18 years of age or older may present and jog the horse.

5. Each horse must be presented with its entry number and a current negative Coggins test, passport, or USEF proof of horse registration. Following the official horse inspection, the assigned back number must always accompany the horse when it is out of its stall and must be visible on the stall door otherwise.

6. Horses not accepted at the horse inspection will have the opportunity to be re-presented once prior to the First Individual Qualifying Class.

7. If a horse is not accepted at the initial horse inspection, the horse may not participate in the Championship Training session if it is held prior to the re-inspection. Horses not accepted at the re-inspection will not be allowed to compete in the championships nor may they participate in any concurrently held competition during which the championship is held on the same grounds for a period of 48 hours following the horse inspection. (GR914.3)

Tack/ Equipment

1. USEF Rules: USEF rules will govern these Championships. (JP111). Additionally, please pay particular attention to the specifics listed below:

2. The use of draw reins, German Martingales, Chambons, or any other unconventional equipment are not allowed at any time during the championships, including schooling. Exception: The use of draw reins is permissible during awards presentations and victory gallops.

3. Boot regulations- Refer to rule JP111.5.

Athlete Rules and Regulations

1. Although an athlete is not prevented from competing on another horse during the championship, there will be no waiting during the championship classes. If an athlete is not immediately available in the order, the athlete will be scratched from that championship class.

2. Failure to enter the ring within one minute of being called incurs elimination. The time limit for entering the ring must be enforced by management. (JP136.2)

3. Riders' Meeting: There will be a mandatory riders' meeting and Show Jumping Athlete Pathway Orientation presentation; time and location will be announced. The riders' meeting will not be more than 24 hours prior to the 1st qualifying class.

Schooling

1. USEF Jumper Schooling Rules will be in effect throughout the competition (JP103) and Appendix

Attire (JP111.9)

1. Official horse inspection and course walks

a. Athletes and/or designated representatives must be appropriately dressed. Athletes must wear boots, breeches, and a helmet A designated representative must be professionally dressed for the official horse inspection, including wearing appropriate footwear. Please refer to USEF rule JP111.9c

 Horses competing in the ZJTC may not compete in any other class at the same horse show after the official horse inspection has taken place. Exception: ZJTC Training class, if offered.

The horse inspection will be held no more than 24 hours prior to the start of the First Individual Qualifying Class. 4. A designated representative other than the rider, who must be at least 18 years of age, may present the horse at the horse inspection.

Following the horse inspection, the assigned back number must always accompany the horse when it is out of its stall and must be visible on the stall door when in the stall.

b. Horses not accepted at the horse inspection will have the opportunity to be represented once, prior to the First Individual Qualifying Class.

c. If a horse is not accepted at the initial horse inspection the horse may not participate in the ZJTC Training Session if it is held prior to the re-inspection. Horses not accepted at the re-inspection will not compete in the ZJTC. Horses may not participate in any concurrently held competition during which the ZJTC is held 48 hours following the horse inspection. (GR914.3)

B. Tack/ Equipment USEF rules will govern these ZJTCs. (JP 111). Additionally, please pay particular attention to the specifics below:

1. Martingales

a. Standing martingales, Running Martingales and Irish martingales are permitted in the 1.10/1.15m ZJTC and the 1.20/1.25m ZJTC.

b. The use of any other type of martingale will be cause for elimination from that ZJTC class.

c. The use of draw reins, German martingales, chambons, or any other unconventional equipment is not allowed at any time during the ZJTCs, including schooling. Exception: The use of draw reins is permissible during awards presentations and victory gallops.

2. Equipment

a. Boot regulations- Refer to rule JP111.5.

Athlete Rules and Regulations

1. Although an athlete is not prevented from competing on another horse during the ZJTC week there will be no waiting for that athlete/horse during the ZJTC classes. If an athlete is not immediately available in the order, the athlete will be scratched from that ZJTC class.

2. Failure to enter the ring within one minute of being called incurs elimination. The time limit for entering the ring must be enforced by management. (JP137)

3. Only the competing athlete may be mounted on the ZJTC horse after the official Horse Inspection.

4. Riders' meeting: There will be a mandatory riders' meeting and Show Jumping Athlete Pathway Orientation presentation: The time and location will be included in the prize list and schedule.

5. The draw for the Team Order of Go will take place at the Riders' Meeting.

6. Teams will be determined two weeks prior to the ZJTC and are subject to change should a member of a team scratch. All necessary changes will be communicated to the Zone Chefs d'Equipe.

7. To hold a ZJTC, a minimum of three teams must be entered in each section or combined section. Teams may be combined by sections or height and /or combined section, height, and zone. A. Schooling

1. USEF Jumper Schooling Rules will be in effect throughout the competition (JP 103 and Appendix A).

B. Attire (JP 111.9)

1. Official Horse Inspection and Course Walks

a. Athletes and or designated representatives must be appropriately dressed. Athletes must wear boots, breeches, and a helmet. A designated representative must be professionally dressed and wearing a helmet and proper footwear for the Official Horse Inspection. Please refer to USEF rule JP 111.9c.

2. First Individual Qualifier and Team Competition

a. White breeches: and zone team shirts are encouraged. Shirts must have collars and sleeves (sleeves may be long or short) and must be tucked into breeches. Sleeveless shirts and shirts with exposed hoods are prohibited. If team shirts are not available, athletes must follow the Formal Attire dress code. (JP 111.9a)

b. All athletes on each team must all wear coordinated shirts or Otherwise, athletes must wear formal attire. Boots are required, and half chaps are permitted providing the color matches the paddock boot.

3. Individual Final

a. Formal Attire required. (JP111.9a)

1. PJC horses must be stabled on the show grounds, in official horse stabling beginning no later than one hour prior to the horse inspection and remain on the grounds until the completion of the PJC.

2. Horses competing in the PJCmay not compete in any other class at the same horse show after the official horse inspection has taken place. Exception: Official PJC Training class, if offered.

3. All PJC horses must be presented at the mandatory horse inspection by the athlete or designated representative. The horse inspection will be held no more than 24 hours prior to the start of the First Individual Qualifying Class. The exact time and location will be included in the prize list and schedule for each PJC.

4. A designated representative other than the rider, who must be at least 18 years of age, may present the horse at the horse inspection.

a. Each horse must be presented with its entry number and current Coggins and or passport. (USEF proof of horse registration) Following the horse inspection, the assigned back number must always accompany the horse when it is out of its stall and must be visible on the stall door when in the stall.

b. Horses not accepted at the horse inspection will have the opportunity to be re-presented once, prior to the First Individual Qualifying Class.

c. If a horse is not accepted at the initial horse inspection, the horse may not participate in the PJC Training Session if it is held prior to the re-inspection. Horses not accepted at the re-inspection will not compete in the PJC. Horses may not participate in any concurrently held competition during which the PJC for 48 hours following the horse inspection. (GR914.3)

A. Tack/ Equipment USEF rules will govern these PJCs. (JP 111). Additionally, please pay particular attention to the specifics below:

1. Martingales

a. Only running martingales used in a conventional manner are permitted in the Platinum Championships. (JP111.1b)

b. The use of any other type of martingale will be cause for elimination from that Championship class. Exception: Irish Martingales may be used.

c. The use of DrawReins, German Martingales, Chambon's, or any other unconventional equipment is not allowed at any time during the PJCs, including when schooling. Exception: The use of Draw Reins is permissible during awards presentations and victory gallops.

2. Boot regulations- Refer to rule JP111.5.

B. Athlete Rules and Regulations

1. Although an athlete is not prevented from competing on another horse during the PJC week there will be no waiting for that athlete/horse during the PJC classes. If an

athlete is not immediately available in the order, the athlete will be scratched from that PJC class.

2. For the order of go for classes with non-Platinum and Platinum horses entered, the Platinum horse must be ridden first.

3. Failure to enter the ring within one minute of being called incurs elimination. The time limit for entering the ring must be enforced by management. (JP137)

4. Only the competing athlete may be mounted on the PJC horse after the official Horse Inspection.

5. Riders' meeting: There will be a mandatory riders' meeting and Show Jumping Athlete Pathway Orientation presentation. The time and location will be included in the prize list and schedule.

6. The draw for the Team Order of Go will take place at the Riders' Meeting.

7. Teams will be determined two weeks prior to the PJC and are subject to change should a member of a team scratch. All necessary changes will be communicated to the Zone Chefs d'Equipe.

8. To hold a PJC, a minimum of three teams must be entered in each section or combined section. Teams may be combined by section or height and /or combined section, height, and zone.

C. Schooling

a. USEF Jumper Schooling Rules will be in effect throughout the competition (JP 103) and Appendix A.

D. Attire (JP 111.9)

1. Official Horse Inspection and Course Walks

FEI COMPETITORS IMPORTANT INFORMATION

For FEI class information, entry fee and class specifications see FEI section definite schedules at <u>www.fei.org</u>. The FEI Definite Schedule supersedes any information regarding FEI classes/competitions that is printed in this prize list.

Exhibitors are responsible for having their Federations declare their horses for the FEI competition BEFORE the close of entries as listed in the FEI Definite Schedule each week. Defininite entries must be made to your Federation by the Thursday prior to the competition week unless otherwise stated in the Schedule. This Federation weekly declaration is the automatic nomination into the Jog. The Horse Show Office will determine the entries for each and every FEI week based solely off of the Definite Entries submitted on the FEI Entry System for that week. The athlete must manually withdraw any horse he/she does not plan to show before the jog to avoid paying the Late Withdrawal Fee as indicated in the FEI Schedule. Proper entries and withdrawals in the Jog are the sole responsibility of the athlete. We ask that you only declare the number of horses that are allowed each week. We will allow substitutions made by Federations up until 1 hour prior to the Jog/Horse Inspection.

Class Declarations must be done in the Horse Show Office each week on an official Add/Scratch sheet or online no later than 4:00pm the day before the class is held unless otherwise noted. Declarations made after that time may be accepted by Management only and, if accepted, will result in that horse going first in the order (draw) in the competition in question.

FEI STABLING: Please notify the Stabling Office each week BEFORE the Jog/Horse Inspection/stabling time to secure your stall location. FEI Entry Fee includes one stall. Additional FEI stalls, if available, are \$350.00 per additional stall per week. Stables will be open to receive horses per the FEI Definite Schedule. All horses being admitted to FEI Stabling must have completed the FEI temp records via FEI APP. Any early arrivals must be approved by the Stabling Manager. All horses living in FEI stabling, whether showing or not, must obey all FEI Rules.

FEI JOG: Please check FEI draft schedules for official jog times. Any changes to the FEI Jog/Horse Inspection will be posted in the FEI area and the Horse Show Office. Both horse and rider must be current FEI members in order to present at the Jog/Horse Inspection.

Credentials are required for entrance to the FEI Compound at all times. Credentials are signed out by the FEI Office in the FEI Compound. Five passes will be issued per horse: Rider (1), Trainer of record signing the entry blank (1), Groom (1), and Owner of record as listed in the passport (2).
