Procurement Quality Requirements

This document establishes specific quality requirements that apply when specified by QR code on Baker Manufacturing, Inc. purchase orders. Additional requirements and instructions may be included on the purchase order. These are in addition to any other contractual requirements.

QR1 Right of Access

Baker Manufacturing, its customer and any regulatory authorities shall have access to facilities at any level of the supply chain and the specific quality records involved in the processing of this order. Access will only be permitted with advanced written notification and a date that is mutually agreeable to the parties.

QR2 Supplier Approval

Baker Manufacturing reserves the right to audit the seller's product and services, procedures or processes prior to, or during fulfillment of the contract.

Supplier is expected to maintain quality objectives of at least 95% acceptance rate and less than 2% scrap.

QR3 Quality System

Seller must have a Quality Management System accepted by buyer and subsequently be a buyer approved vendor or one that is on the approved supplier list.

QR4 Record Retention

Quality records shall be maintained at your facility for a minimum of 11 years from date of shipment, unless otherwise stated in contract. Records shall be made available upon request. After retention period contact for disposition.

QR5 Flow Down of Requirements

All requirements of this purchase order, including any key characteristics, shall be flowed down to seller's sub-tier supplier.

QR10 Changes in Process or Product

Seller shall notify Baker Manufacturing for review and approval of any changes in product and/or process definition, changes of suppliers, and changes of the manufacturer facility. Seller agrees not to make any change in materials, processes or design, which would affect the part or any component part thereof, without prior written approval from Baker Manufacturing.

QR11 Certificate of Conformance

Seller shall provide a legible and reproducible copy of a Certificate of Conformance (COC) or pack slip, with Baker Manufacturing purchase order clearly noted and signature of a responsible representative stating the material, process, or article being shipped meets requirements of applicable drawings or specifications cited in the purchase order. The COC shall include part, drawing, or process revision, and shall be traceable to the original manufacturer and all other required certifications by means of a lot number, date code, material PO number or equivalent.

QR12 First Article Inspection

The seller shall perform First Article Inspections (FAI), as stipulated by PO, in accordance with AS9102. A copy shall be provided on the first shipment. FAI shall also be conducted and provided when lapses in production exceed 24 months, when changes in process or configuration occur, or as otherwise directed.

QR13 Certificate of Analysis or Test Report

Seller shall provide a legible and reproducible Certificate of Analysis (COA) or physical properties test report. Chemical and/or physical test data shall include actual numerical values for each property tested in accordance with the applicable specification or purchase order requirements. The COA or test report shall be traceable to the original manufacturer and all other required certifications by means of a lot number, date code, material PO number, or equivalent. Supplied materials should be DOMESTIC OR DFAR'S MATERIALS ONLY.

QR14 Inspection Data

The seller shall furnish a legible and reproducible copy of inspection data sheets that record objective evidence of acceptance for each assembly, sub-assembly, or component covered by this purchase order. This requirement applies to Baker Manufacturing's suppliers to the extent necessary to determine acceptability of items under this purchase order. other required certifications by means of a lot number, date code, material PO number, or equivalent.

QR6 Report of Discrepancy

Any departure from drawings, specifications or other purchase order requirements, discovered prior to or after shipment, shall be documented by the seller and submitted to Baker Manufacturing for review at time of realization.

QR 15 Counterfeit Parts

Seller shall notify Baker Manufacturing, immediately if the Seller suspects they may have supplied counterfeit products. Delivered product that contains counterfeit parts and / or materials will be replaced at the Sellers expense. Seller bears the responsibility for procuring authentic parts and /or materials from its suppliers and shall ensure that all sub-tier suppliers comply with these requirements(Reference AS6174 Counterfeit Material; Assuring Acquisition of Authentic and **Conforming Materials**

QR 7 Time and Temperature Sensitive Materials

Seller shall identify all time and temperature sensitive materials (TATS) with necessary information stating proper storage condition required to achieve the stated life. Information shall indicate the date useful life was initiated and the date or cycle at which the useful life will be expended.

QR 16 Digital Product Definition (DPD)

Sellers using Baker Manufacturing. Supplied DPD for the purposes of manufacturing and/or inspection of customer supplied DPD product must be in compliance with the requirement set forth.

QR 8 Customer and Designated External Providers and Special **Process Requirements**

Each shipment of material, parts, or assemblies, shall be accompanied by a legible and reproducible copy of special process certifications (e.g. Testing, heat treat, nondestructive testing, etc.). Special processes shall be performed by a customer approved source as defined by the process specification owner.

OR 17 Foreign Object Debris/ Damage (FOD) Prevention

The Seller shall ensure work is accomplished in a manor to prevent foreign objects or material in deliverable items. Seller shall maintain work areas, tools, parts, and materials in a manner sufficient to preclude the risk of FOD

QR9 Qualification of Personnel

Personnel training/qualification records must be maintained by the seller, and be available for review by Baker Manufacturing.

QR18 Product Safety

The Seller shall supply product and service conformity with the contribution made to quality as product safety and ethical behavior is important as a supplier for Baker Manufacturing.
