Award Prizes

The 2024 Fraser Award is comprised of:

A trophy, certificate and prize pool of about \$5000 for learning and professional development costs

An all inclusive package to attend the NZPPI annual conference on May 15 and 16 in Hamilton.

Criteria

It is open to nominated individuals of any age who:

- Work in the plant production industry or a related industry.
- Are enrolled or have recently completed (within 3 years of their nomination) training and education in an area related to plant production
- Demonstrate a passion for plants, a love of learning and an enthusiasm for the industry.
- Display a positive and co-operative attitude towards colleagues and customers/clients
- Have the aptitude and focus to work for the betterment of the industry
- Are available to attend the NZPPI conference.

Timing

The 2024 award nominations open in March and close on April 24 2024.

A judging panel will interview nominees in April.

The winner will be notified then announced at the NZPPI conference awards dinner on Wednesday May 15th in Hamilton.

Terms and Conditions

Award nominees must meet the outlined criteria.

Nominations must only be submitted by people currently working within the plant production industry, on behalf of the nominees.

Nomination forms must be completed and emailed to NZPPI to arrive by April 24 2024.

Award nominees must supply a minimum of two industry referees to be contacted during the judging process.

Completion of an nomination form does not guarantee entry into the Fraser Award.

The winning recipient must be available to attend the NZPPI conference on May 15 and 16 in Hamilton.

The judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

All prizes are to be accepted as given and how cash prizes are expended are subject to discussion with the judging panel.

Award recipient will be available to give media interviews and promote the award.
