### WHEN IS IT?

**Main Festival** - Friday 9th-Sunday 11th August 2024 (*standard weekend tickets and day tickets*)

**Pre Festival Party** - Thursday 8th August 2024 (*The Long Weekend Ticket holders only, this includes pre festival party & main festival too, adults only for pre festival party*)

### ARRIVING AT THE FESTIVAL

#### Location

Firevolt Rock Festival is located in the beautiful Etherow Country Park at:

Compstall  
Etherow Country Park  
Stockport

**SK6 5JE** (*please only use this postcode*), it takes you to Montagu St, proceed to the end and present your On-Site Parking Pass to Security.

#### **On-Site Parking Passes are ONLY for:**

Access-Blue Badge Holders/Live In Vehicles/Press Passes/Traders/Artists

(this is due to Firevolt's Licencing and to reduce the Carbon Emissions, Residential and Wildlife impact).

## Driving & Car Park

Official Off-Site Car Park - **SK6 5HH** (Compstall Rd, follow the yellow festival parking signs)

Please book Official Festival Car Parking via our website under 'book tickets' or go directly to Firevolt Festival on Gigantic and scroll down to 'car parking'.

We strongly advise booking car parking in advance as space is limited, on the day purchases are subject to availability. Advanced booking closes on **Sunday 4th August 2024**, (please have your car parking ticket ready for inspection on arrival.)

**Pre Booked tickets** - weekend £20 & day £15 (+ booking fee)

**On the day parking subject to availability** (cash only) - weekend £30 & Day £20

Due to the high cost of renting the land and staffing it, we are unable to offer any discounts on parking

## Parking is from/to:

**The Long Weekend Tickets** - Thursday 1pm, last entry at 7.45pm to Monday 3pm

**Weekend Tickets** - Friday & Saturday 10am, last entry 7.45pm. Sunday 10am, last entry 5.45pm to Monday 3pm

**Day Tickets** - Day of arrival, departure on same day. (times above)

Cars must depart car park by **3pm Monday 12th Aug 2024**. (see below for opening times). Car Parking tickets are valid even if you leave site and return (car parking staff will make a note of your registration). Please do not leave valuables in your car - parking at owners' risk.

Parking locally is extremely limited, there is only one public car park, which you can only pay for on a daily basis and tickets need to be renewed by 7.30am for the following day.

## Travel

### The nearest train stations are:

- Marple
- Romiley

### The nearest main train station is:

- Stockport



### There are regular bus services:

The **383** departs from Mersey Square (7 min walk) from Stockport train station.

The **384** departs from Heaton Lane Bus Station (9 min walk) from Stockport Train Station.

These both stop in Romiley & Marple, disembark at Compstall Village for the Festival (Check Stagecoach timetables).

### FREE Festival Shuttle Bus - for all festival ticket holders parking or not!

The shuttle bus (with trailer for all your camping gear) only goes from the Official Car Park - **SK6 5HH** & will bring you to the site and back to the car park! (see shuttle bus timings below)

**PLEASE NOTE:** Only guide dogs are allowed on the shuttle bus, this is for passenger safety and part of the insurance.

### Walk This Way (we're at it again!!)

Head through the beautiful Etherow Country Park which is around a **15-20 min walk**.

Here's the postcode - **SK6 5JE** (Please Note - The Shuttle Bus is not permitted to pick up and drop off Festival Goers from anywhere other than the Official Car Park and the Festival Gate Entrance.)

## Festival Entrance

**Security** - checks/bag search, we adhere to a strictly no drugs policy

**Please note** - only limited alcohol for personal use is allowed in the campsite but strictly not to be taken into the arena. As this is a working farm

**NO GLASS** is permitted on site.

## Ticket Scanning & Wristbands

## Bar

The 99.7ft long bar is operated by the landowners who permit us to use their beautiful site for the festival, please support the bar.

Bar sells competitively priced Lager, Cider, IPA, Trooper, Guinness, spirits & mixers. The land owners operate a cashless bar system using tokens, which are available to purchase at the right hand side of the main bar in the barn with cash or card.

## What's On Site

**Permanent Toilet Blocks** - with real flushing loos and proper toilet paper!!!!

**Permanent Shower Block** - with hot showers and electrical sockets in shower changing area - open daily **7-11am**

**Glamping** - [www.thecanvasco.co.uk/firevolt](http://www.thecanvasco.co.uk/firevolt)

**Food** – there's a variety of festival food vendors including breakfast, Gluten Free, Vegetarian & Vegan options and hot and cold drinks, accepting cash and/or card payment

**Festival Retailers** – accepting cash and/or card payment, retailing – clothing, jewellery, vinyl records, glitter/face painting etc

**Cash** – there are no cash machines on site, however cash back is available on the main bar

**Stages** – both stages are under cover (*Trooper (Barn) partially & Big Top*)

**Band Merch** – available on the day of performance

**Merch Stall** – Firevolt Merch will be available at the festival, why not pre-order and collect at the festival to avoid disappointment, visit our store:

## **STAYING ON SITE**

### **Camping**

The campsites are provided for camping ticket holders only. All camping is a minute or two from the festival gate, we have help available if you need assistance from the gate to your pitch!

### **Camping Areas**

Oak Tree – right hand field

Tight Wad Hill' (*Green Day Reference!*) – right hand field up a slight hill with fantastic panoramic views of the site

Glamping and Pamper Point (*glampers only*) – by advanced booking only, make you way to Glamping Reception with confirmation of your booking

Big Top Field – left hand field

Please note – tents pitched next to Live In Vehicles are done so at your own risk. We strongly advise you not to do so due to potential fire hazard also you must remain within the pitch sized purchased.

### **Live In Vehicles**

There are no electric hook ups on site

Elsan point available at the side of the ladies shower/toilet block

Water containers can be filled up at the front of the shower/toilet block

Please display your onsite parking pass at all times

### **Alternative Off-Site Campsite for Live In Vehicles**

**We have two Off-site Live In Vehicle options:**

**1. Compstall road – SK6 5HH** (*this is our official off-site car park, approx. 1 mile from festival gate*)

- Portable toilets on site
- Free festival shuttle bus
- Arrival – Thursday from 1pm, last entrance 7.45pm (*for Long Weekend Ticket holders only*)
- Arrival – Friday/Saturday from 10am, last entrance 7.45pm (*standard weekend ticket holders*)
- Departure – Monday by 3pm

Not suitable for Caravans please check out our OFF-SITE Whitecroft Farm below

### **2. Whitecroft Farm Strines, Marple, Stockport, SK22 3AH**

This is a campsite and is Approx. 3.5 miles to the festival gate

#### **Facilities:**

- Toilet on Site
- Electric Hook Up available
- We run a time tabled shuttle bus as below, (*please purchase the shuttle bus ticket from our website if required*)

Thursday collect at 5.30pm returning at Midnight

Friday, Saturday & Sunday – Collect at 11.30am & return at 11.30pm

Or use local taxi company/Uber

Please be respectful of your fellow campers if using amplified music. There is a No-noise policy in place after 1am which is monitored by security.

## **Access Camping & Parking**

Will be positioned as close as possible to all amenities and stages. If you have granted a parking on-site car parking pass, please display pass in your vehicle at all times.

There is a permanent toilet available to access guest only which can be found to the left of the Trooper Stage, as well as a portable Accessible toilet.

## **BBQs**

No foil disposable BBQs or open fires permitted – we don't want any Smoke on the Water! (*sorry, we just can't help it!!*) However, you may use camping stoves or barbecues on legs (*in the campsite area only*).

Own food is not permitted in the Festival Arena (*snacks are though!*) but is permitted in the campsite.

## **Staying Safe**

### **Strobe Lighting**

Please be aware strobe lighting could be a part of the performances taking place.

### **Loud Music**

Please be aware, loud music will play during the whole of the festival duration. Adequate protection should be considered and is freely available onsite, on our merch stall, just ask the team!

### **Valuables**

It is advisable to keep your valuables with you and not to leave them unattended or in your tent.

### **Sun Exposure**

Please bring suitable sun protection with you and ensure you stay hydrated. Free drinking water will be available from the main bar and drinking water points around the site.

### **Drug Policy**

We operate a strict no drug or legal high policy and as such, if discovered by our search teams you will be refused entry or ejected from the event without refund. Prescription cannabis – please have a copy of your prescription and the dispensing label from the pharmacist on your medication.

### **Smoking Policy**

Smoking is not permitted in the Trooper Stage, Barn Area or the Big Top. Please use designated smoking areas.

### **Fold Away Chairs**

Are allowed in the arenas but please don't block exits and thoroughways!

### **First Aid & Medical Team**

We have a dedicated team of first aiders and responders on-site for the event

### **Staff & Volunteers**

Look out for our Firevolt staff or volunteers at the festival, if you have any questions or need help, they're a great bunch!!!

### **Solo Guests**

If you are attending the festival as a solo guest, we will be doing a meet up under the veranda of the Bus Bar on:

Thursday 8th Aug – 5.30pm

Friday 9th Aug – 1.45pm

### **Age**

The festival is open age, under 18s must be accompanied by an adult. The site has 2 large ponds, please supervise children at all times.

### **Dogs**

Our furry dog friends will be welcome onsite in limited numbers, they must remain on a lead and please tidy up after them. Any banned breed will not be permitted onsite and Firevolt reserves the right to refuse entry or ask guests to leave if dogs misbehave with no refund offered. Only guide dogs are permitted to travel on our shuttle bus.

You will receive a unique link via email from Firevolt on Thursday 15th August 2024, which will enable you to purchase tickets before anyone else. These tickets will be at the lowest price offered for Firevolt 2025.

The unique link, can only be used once and applies to Long Weekend Tickets & Weekend Tickets (*both with or without camping*)

### Live In Vehicle Tickets

**Please note:** Live In Vehicles sold out within 1.5hrs for 2024. They are available for all those in the pre sale. A link to our booking form will be sent out with your unique Festival ticket payment link on Thursday 15th August 2024. The Live In Vehicle booking form will go live on Saturday 17th August 2024 10am, bookings will be checked against our data base and you will receive an email if successful.

Payment Plans will be available for arena tickets only (*not live in vehicle or day tickets*).

On-site Motorbike Parking and Dog Passes (*dog passes are free*) will also be available in the pre sale.
